

Eugene Ashley High School Nurse Aide Training Health Agency Affiliation Agreement

This is an agreement between Trinity Grove Healthcare facility, 631 Junction Creek Dr, Wilmington, NC 28412, and Eugene Ashley High School Nurse Aide Training Program, 555 Halyburton Memorial PKWY, Wilmington, NC 28412.

It is mutually agreed upon by Eugene Ashley High School NAT program and Trinity Grove healthcare facility, that high school nurse aide students be placed in Trinity Grove, for the clinical application portion of approved NC Nurse Aide Training. Students will provide hands-on nurse aide personal care skills.

Nurse Aide students will be assigned in the following areas:

Basic nursing skills

- (i) Taking and recording vital signs
 - (ii) Measuring and recording height and weight
 - (iii) Caring for the residents' environment
 - (v) Caring for residents when death is imminent.
- (3) Personal care skills, including, but not limited to--
- (i) Bathing
 - (ii) Grooming, including mouth care
 - (iii) Dressing
 - (iv) Toileting
 - (v) Assisting with eating and hydration
 - (vi) Proper feeding techniques
 - (vii) Skin care
 - (viii) Transfers, positioning, and turning

The following provisions are to be observed:

1. Eugene Ashley High School will provide one RN teacher, approved for nurse aide training, for no more than ten nurse aide students.
2. The teacher will supervise and evaluate nurse aide students with minimal assistance from the staff at Trinity Grove.

3. The teacher will communicate with appropriate healthcare agency team members regarding student assignments, schedule, and any other information needed for competent resident care, employee and student safety. It is expected that communications occur in advance for scheduling a clinical experience and a.s.a.p. For emergency changes.
4. The students will follow the healthcare agency's personnel and legal policies and procedures at all times during the affiliation period.
5. The healthcare agency will permit the legal use of equipment and supplies while affiliating.
6. Although the healthcare agency exercises reasonable precaution at all times to avoid injury to residents, employees, and students, the healthcare agency will not be responsible for claims resulting from injury to a nurse aide student participating in clinical.
7. The following practices will be fully implemented by the public-school unit and NCDPI as applicable.

1. All practicing nurse aide students and teachers must meet entry requirements of the healthcare agency prior to the clinical experience.

2. All practicing nurse aide students are required to demonstrate competence in all nurse aide curriculum psychomotor tasks prior to the hands-on clinical experience with RN teacher documentation of the same.

3. New Hanover County Schools agrees to purchase liability insurance for all nurse aide students. The policy will protect students from any liability while participating in the hands-on clinical experience, and protects the healthcare agency from any liability from their serving as an affiliate site.

4. Professional staff development will be afforded to all secondary Health Science Education nurse aide training program teachers regarding their role/function in preparing nurse aide students.
