

FEDERAL PROGRAM MONITORING REVIEW (FPM) Overview

Santa Rosa City Schools Elementary District is going through a Federal Program Monitoring Review (FPM). The Federal program Monitoring is the state's process for meeting their responsibility to monitor federal programs requirements at local educational agencies (LEAs).

CDE monitoring is accomplished in part through the Federal Program Monitoring (FPM) process which is comprised of an onsite or an online review.

SRCS Elementary is scheduled to have an onsite review with CDE (Feb. 7th-10th, 2023).

The State & Federal Programs Coordinator is the lead person in this review. Both the elementary district and individual schools have been chosen by the state to be reviewed. Resources have been created to help site and district administrators better understand their responsibility and offer guidance and support.

The schools being reviewed are Cesar Chavez Language Academy, James Monroe Elementary, Luther Burbank Elementary, Helen Lehman Elementary and Lincoln Elementary.

The areas being reviewed include:

- Federal Stimulus
- Compensatory Education
- Early Learning & Care
- English Learners
- School Support & Improvement
- Uniform Complaint Procedures

Although the FPM review visit takes place in February, this is a yearlong process.

District department leads and site principals whose schools are being reviewed are currently in the process of understanding the process and gathering evidence to prove compliance and accountability.

State reviewers will work with SRCS to support this process as will mentors.

All evidence will be uploaded to folders by December 8th.

The State & Federal Programs will upload all evidence to the CDE Centralized Monitoring Tool by the end of December.

During the visit the reviewers will be looking for findings. School districts have 45 days from the date they have received their notification of findings to make corrections.
