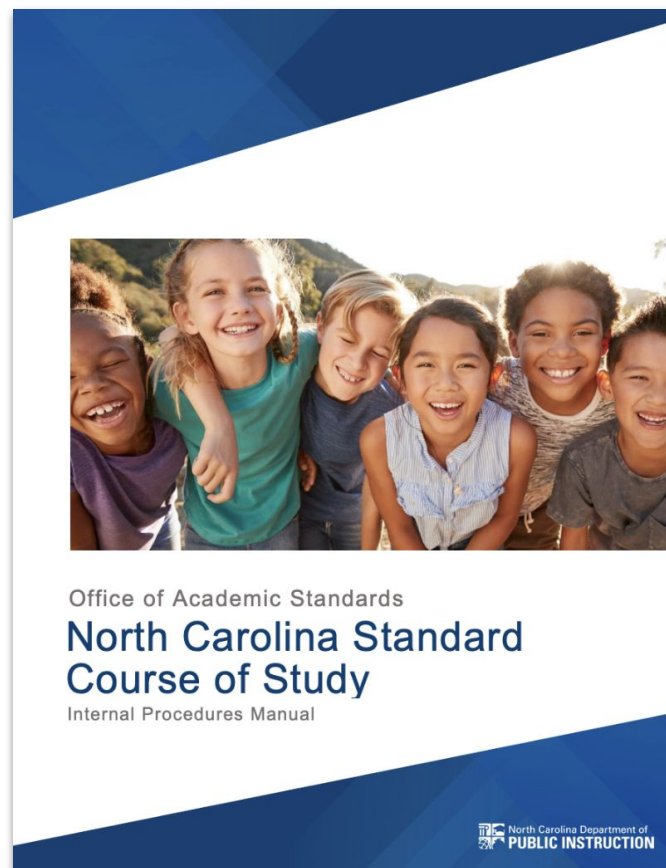
State Board Policy SCOS-012
