SUBJECT: 19F GOVERNANCE NONCOMPLIANCE STATUS – DISCIPLINARY

The North Carolina State Board of Education policy for charter schools on financial and governance noncompliance ([CHTR-006](#)) states that a charter school may be placed on a financial noncompliance status if the school shows signs of financial insolvency or weakness and on governance noncompliance based on any of the seven identified governance warning conditions.

School of the Arts for Boys Academy's ADM of 48 violates § 115C-218.1(b)(13) which requires a minimum of 80 students to be served, if not waived as part of the application the school the may earn governance noncompliance for failure to maintain student enrollment at the establishment at the established minimum, pursuant to [CHTR-006](#).

Due to the issue detailed above, School of the Arts for Boys Academy (19F) is placed on **Governance Noncompliance Disciplinary** status. While on Governance Noncompliance Disciplinary status, the school will receive monthly allotment installments beginning with the second installment allotment and continuing for the remainder of the year.
