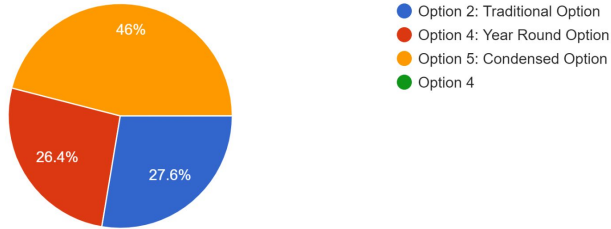

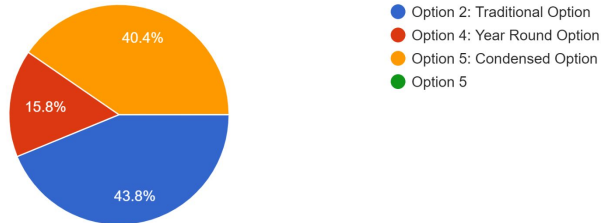
My first choice for the JCPS School Calendar for the 2024-2025 school year is:

3,995 responses



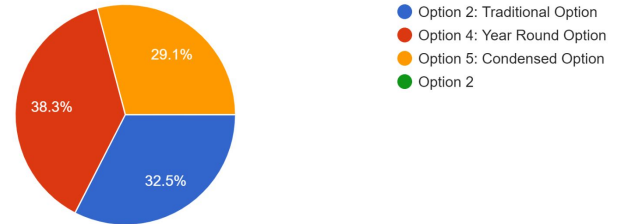
My second choice for the JCPS School Calendar for the 2024-2025 school year is:

My third choice for the JCPS School Calendar for the 2024-2025 school year is:

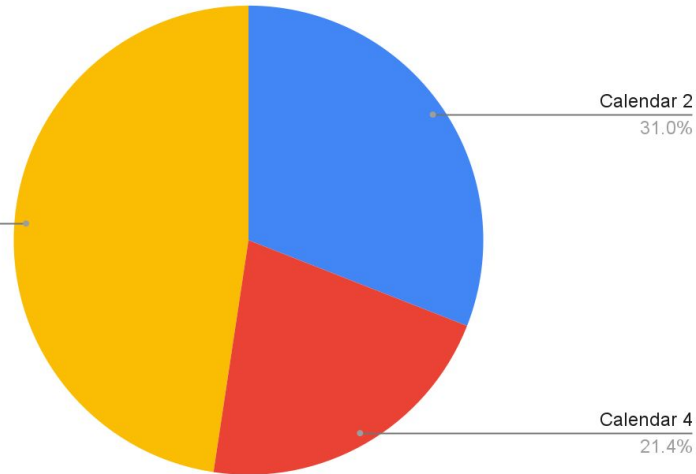

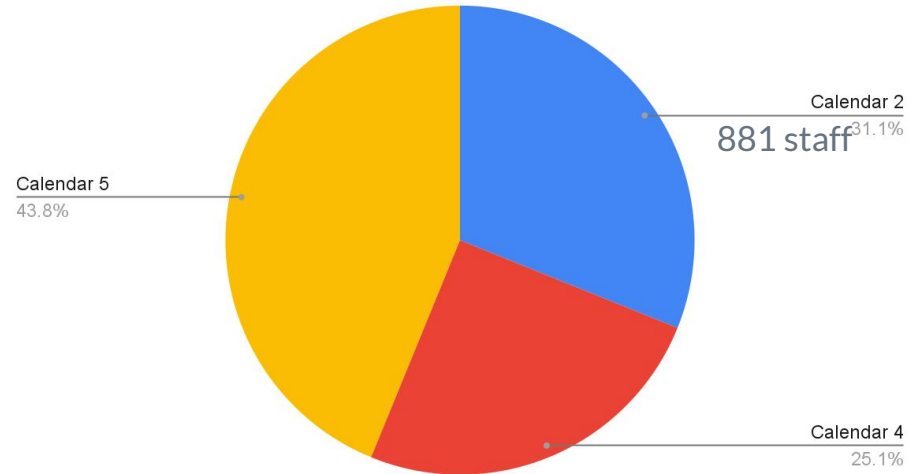
School Improvement Team Feedback

General Trends from SIT Feedback

Liked the modified year round calendar option, but late notification of change does not make feasible for next school year.

- The majority of staff members felt that if JCPS was to adopt a year round calendar it should not be this upcoming school year in 2024-2024 due to little notice provided to our staff and school communities. We have numerous staff members with scheduled trips for vacation during late July into early August. Some of our international teachers have scheduled trips out of the country during those time periods.
- The majority of staff members indicated that adopting a year round choice would be better suited as an option for the 2025-2026 school year as long as the decision is made at an upcoming School Board meeting providing ample notice to families and staff in our community.
- One of the potential negative impacts of adopting a year round calendar for JCPS is the 10 day and 20 day ADM numbers at the beginning of the year. We may have lower numbers of students to start the school year with a first day of school on August 1st that could potentially have a negative effect our state funding.

28 of the 45 schools specifically indicated shifting to modified year round calendar for 2025-26 school year would be more advantageous if given advanced noticed.

- Would provide more to time explore what a year round transition would mean and further explore the structure of track out days.
- Would allow staff, families, and communities to adequately prepare for a transition.

Liked semester and exams ending before Christmas - acknowledged High School scheduling would have to be strategic due to shortened fall semester if went with one of these options.
