## 1.0 Definitions

1. Related Degree: A degree designated for the license area that is aligned to program area and course content.
2. Related Work Experience: Work experience designated for the license area that is aligned to program area, course content, and related degree.
3. 18 Semester Hours, or equivalent:

4. NC CTE New Teacher Institute: A 2-year cohort professional development and coaching program administered through Career and Technical Education at the Department of Public Instruction for initially licensed teachers on the CTE restricted route (program code 35). This program is an equivalent alternative to the combination of 18 semester hours and CTE New Teacher Induction program required to convert initial license to a continuing professional license.

4. Required Credentials: An industry credential/professional license required for the license area that demonstrates current skill level and content knowledge.

5. Required Induction: A 40-hour professional development program administered through NC DPI and called the New CTE Teacher Induction Program.

## 2.00 General Information

2.01 The purpose of this policy is to assist Local Education Agency(LEA) and Department of Public Instruction (DPI) staff to determine eligibility for (i) **initial** licensing of teaching candidates through the Career and Technical Education (CTE) Restricted route (program code 35), (ii) converting the initial license to a continuing professional license (iii) current educators to add CTE teaching areas, and (iv) current educators to add CTE Support Services licenses.

2.02 To be eligible for an Initial Professional License based on the CTE Restricted route (program code 35) teaching candidates shall have the required number of years of related work/military experience for the CTE program area, a related degree from a regionally accredited college or university (high school diploma level licenses do not require a degree), and if the license requires it, a credential prior to hire. This information can be found in Section 3.01 of this

policy for each license area. Related Degrees and Related Work Experience lists are provided as examples. These are not all-inclusive lists of the degrees and work experience that may be considered, rather they show the types of degrees and experiences that may be considered relevant.

2.02.01 Effective July 1, 2022 individuals who did not clear a prior initial CTE restricted license (program code 35) may apply for an initial CTE restricted license **in a different teaching area** (as defined in Section 3.01) provided that the teacher meets all of the requirements for hire as defined in Section 3.0 for the new teaching area.

#### 2.03 Conversion of Initial Professional License Based on the CTE Restricted Route (Program Code 35)

2.03.01 To be eligible to convert the Initial Professional License based on the CTE Restricted route (program code 35) to a Continuing Professional License, candidates must complete credential or other requirements as noted in Section 3.01 of the CTE Licensure Policies and Procedures Manual if required for the license area and

A. complete 18 semester hours as noted in the Definitions section of this policy and the NC DPI Sponsored CTE New Teacher Induction or

B. complete the CTE New Teacher Institute.

2.03.02 All requirements for Initial Professional Licenses based on the CTE Restricted route (program code 35), must be met by the end of the third year to be eligible to convert the license to a Continuing Professional License.

2.03.03 Requirements to clear or convert a provisional initial CTE license issued under prior years' State Board of Education approved policy may be met according to revised currently approved CTED-004.

2.03.04 NCDPI CTE will maintain the NC CTE Teacher Training Institute. This 2 year cohort model will serve as a second option for fulfilling initial CTE restricted licensure course and induction requirements for teachers who receive an initial professional license on or after July 1, 2020.

2.04 Initial Professional Licenses obtained through the CTE Restricted License route result in a restricted Continuing Professional License. The license is restricted from adding additional non-CTE areas. CTE areas may be added as long as the educator holds the minimum degree level for the additional area. For example, educators with a Continuing Professional License in a CTE area based on a high school diploma, may add other CTE areas also based on a high school diploma. In this example, areas that require an associate or bachelor's degree could not be added. See Section 4.0 for criteria for clear add ons and provisional add ons to initial and continuing professional licenses.

## 4.0 Adding Additional CTE Areas

Educators who hold a clear and continuing professional teaching license may add a CTE License Area by meeting **one** of the requirements in the numbered list below. Educators with restricted licenses in a CTE area, may add another CTE area as long as they hold the required degree level for the additional area. All requirements must be met before submitting the application to add the new area to the current license.

Educators with an Initial Professional License or a Continuing Professional License, restricted or non-restricted, are eligible to add an area provisionally if assigned in the area AND if they hold the required degree level for the provisional area. **The LEA must request the provisional license area.** The following CTE license areas are not eligible for provisional status due to student and educator safety concerns: 720 Health Sciences-RN, 74010 T& I-Collision Repair, 74015 T & I-Automotive Service, 74026 T & I-Construction, 74090 T & I-Manufacturing, and 74080 T & I-Welding. Educators have up to five years from the first effective date of the provisional license to complete requirements and clear the provisional status. A request to extend the provisional license area must be submitted annually via the NCDPI Licensure Online System. Educators may choose **one** of the options from the numbered list below. Requirements to clear a provisionally added CTE license area issued under prior years' State Board of Education approved policy may be met according to revised currently approved CTED-004.

- 1) completing an NCSBE approved educator preparation program in the additional area; OR
- 2) satisfying NCSBE approved testing requirements in the additional area; OR
- 3) completing 24 semester hours in the subject area with a grade of "C" or better in each course; OR
- 4) earning industry credentials required for the eligible license (*see licenses eligible for add on via this option in table below*); OR
- 5) meeting eligibility criteria and completing requirements for the CTE Support Services license areas. To add a license in a CTE Support Services area, candidates **MUST** have the required degree, required work experience, **AND** a current continuing professional license at the time of application for the provisional CTE Support Services license. See section 4.1\*

*\*Career Development Facilitator, TBD, does not require a continuing professional license but does require the degree and related work experience. See section 4.1.*
