About the NC Textbook Commission

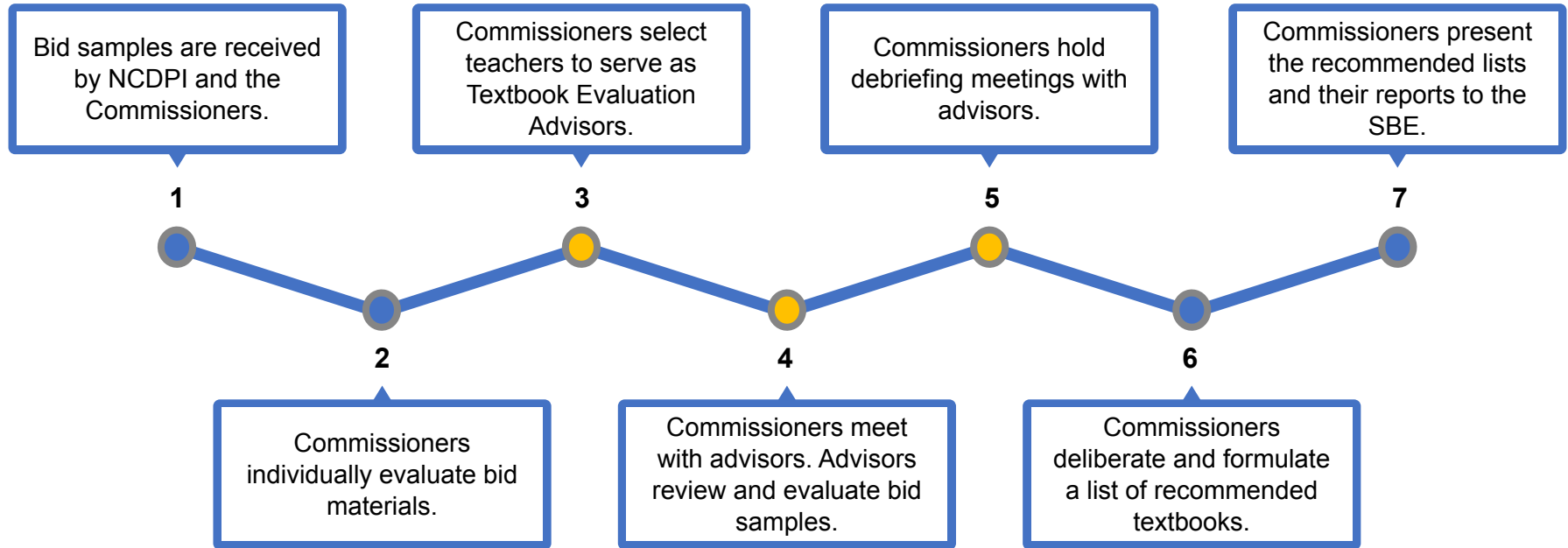
The Textbook Commission consists of **parents, principals, and teachers** who represent elementary, middle school, and high school levels and one **superintendent** of a local school administrative unit.

The purpose of the Commission is to provide PSUs a list of state adopted reviewed resources which are standards aligned.

According to SBE Policy, TEXT-003, the Textbook Commission:

- Evaluates instructional materials/textbooks
- Appoints advisors to assist in the evaluation of textbooks and directs them in the performance of their duties.
- Makes recommendations to the State Board of Education.
