## YONDR Survey

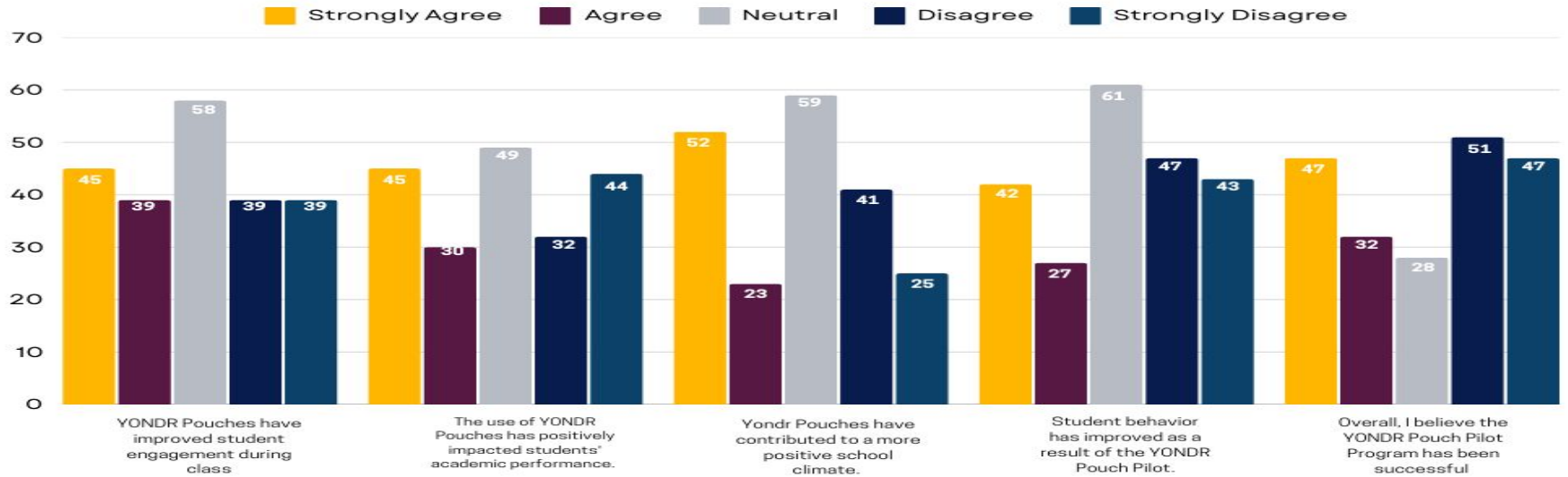

Surveyed staff members, parents, and students

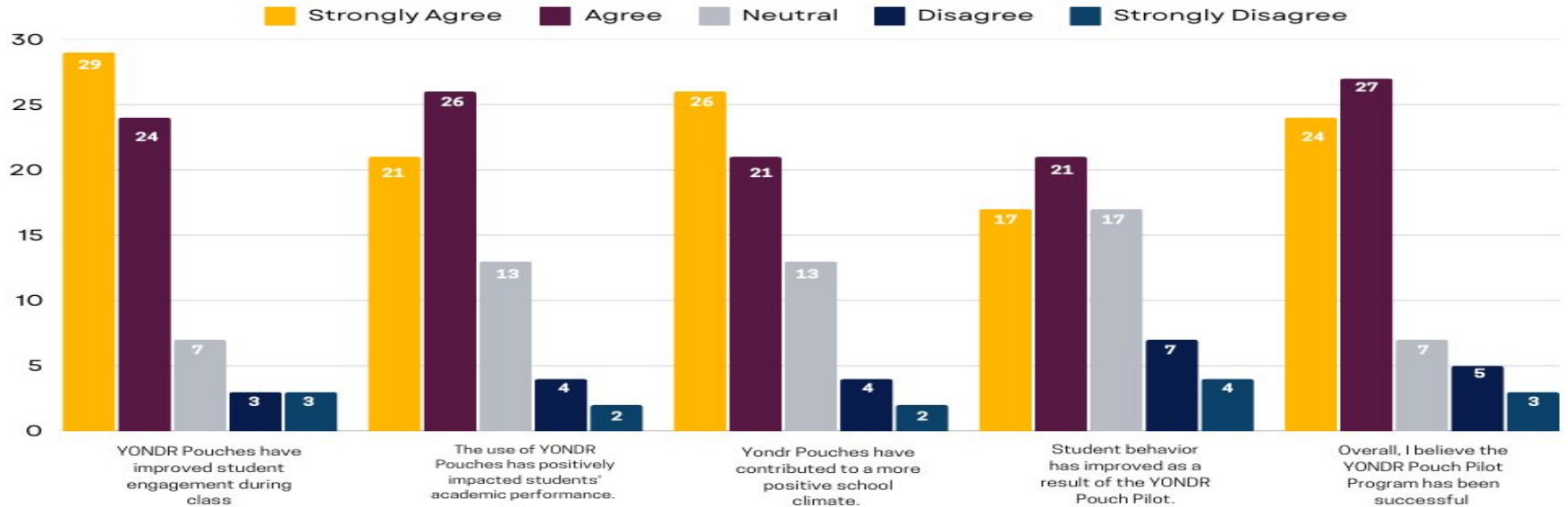
- Over 935 responses to the survey
  - Over 600 student responses
  - Over 221 parent/guardian responses
  - Almost 70 teacher responses
- Survey focused on Yondr's impact on:

  - academic performance
  - school climate
  - student behavior



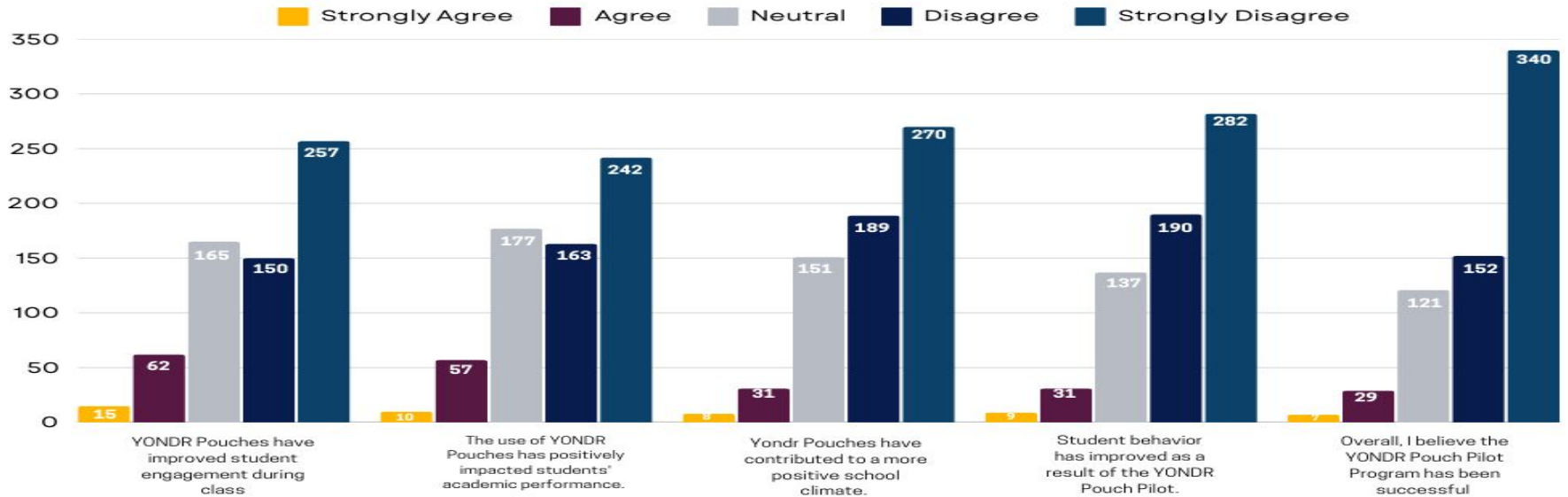

## Student Engagement

---

- Students interviewed at Jordan-Matthews and George Moses Horton said that they are able to focus more in their classes
- Teachers have reported students collaborating more in class and being more focused during instructional time.

## Academics

---

- At the end of first semester of 2023-2024, Seaforth had 251 “F”s. At the end of first semester of 2024-2025, they had 59 “F”s. That is a 76% reduction.
- Students interviewed at Jordan-Matthews and George Moses Horton reported having higher grades this school year

## School Climate

---

- Administrators have noted that students more connected to school activities, teachers and their peers
- Administrators reported that teachers seem more satisfied with their classroom environment

## Suspension Data

---

- The Schools Implementing Yondr Pouches have 31% less suspensions as a collective than they did at the end of February 2024.
