

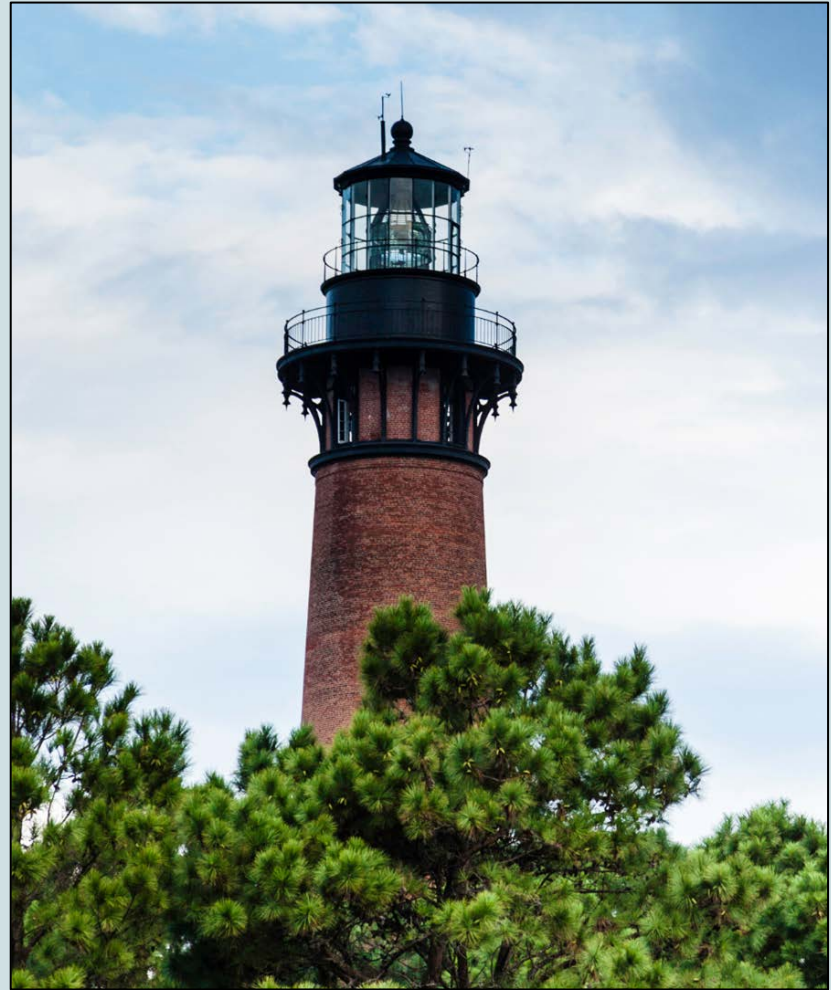

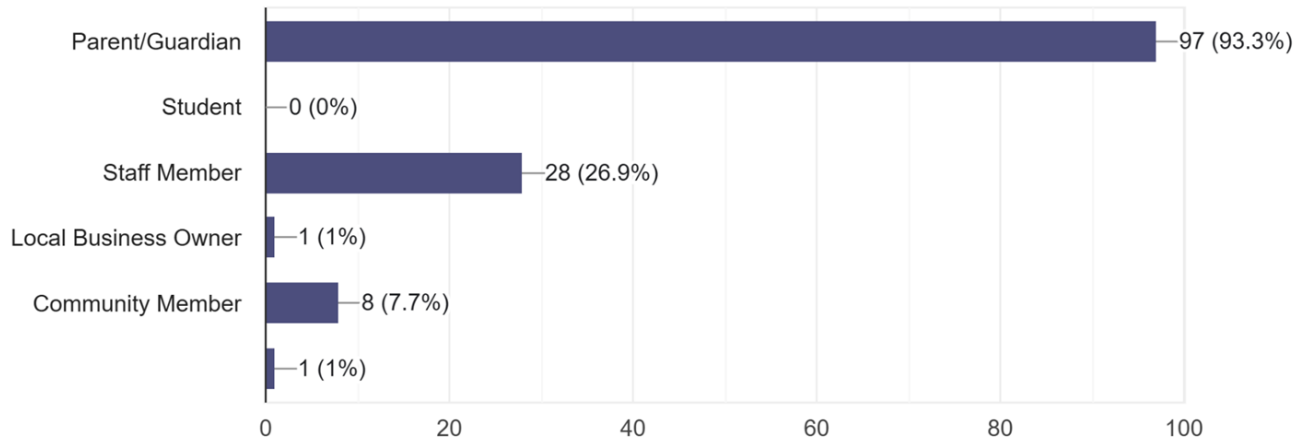

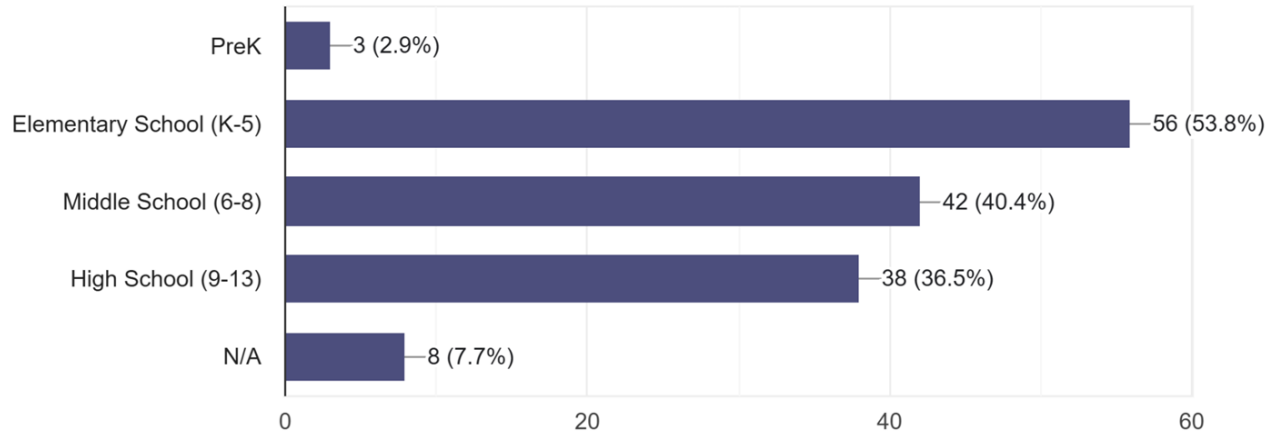


The majority of stakeholders who responded described their relationship with the district as Parents/Guardians and/or Staff.

Stakeholders who responded had children in various grade levels:

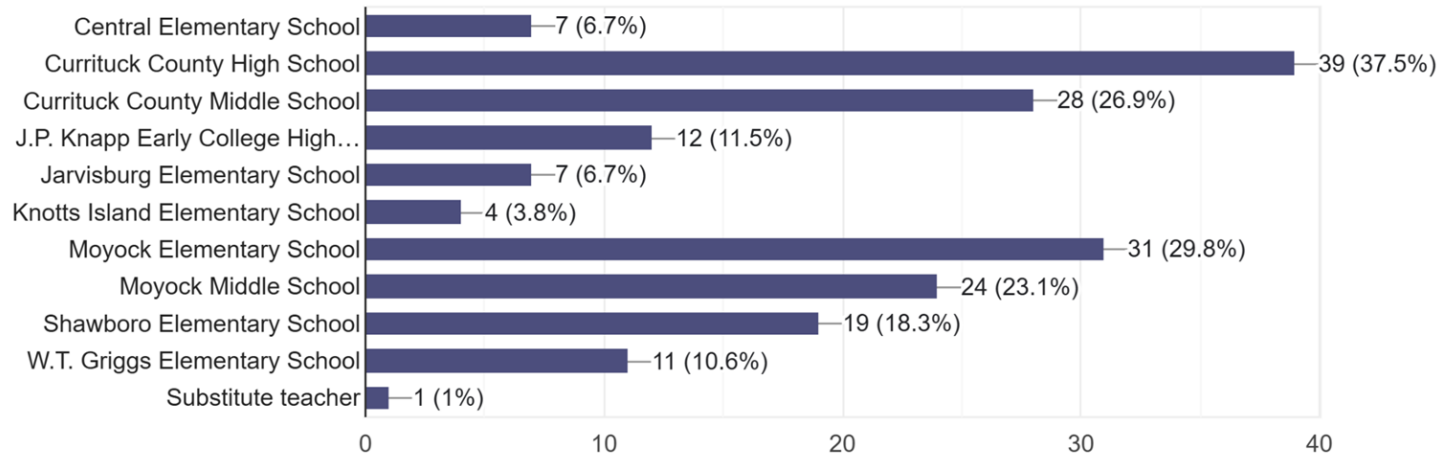
- PreK - 3%

Which school(s) are you most connected to in the district? (Select all that apply)

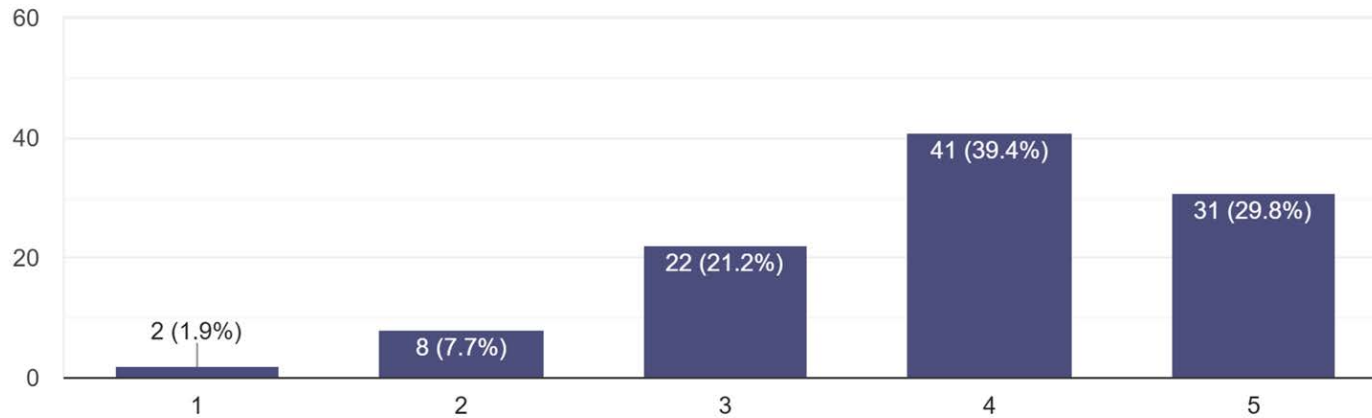

- 9.6% responding with 1 or 2

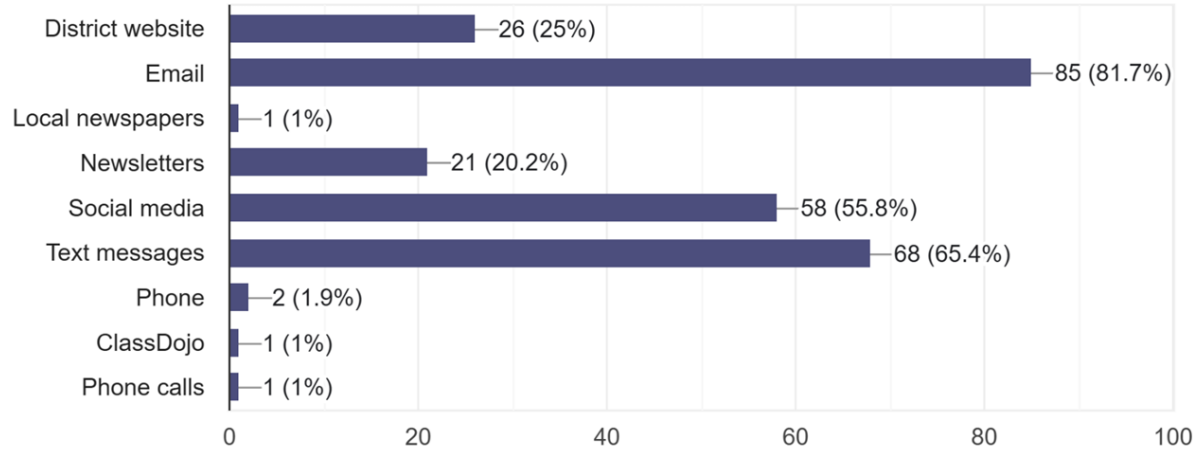

Which communication channels do you prefer for receiving school district information? (Select all that apply)

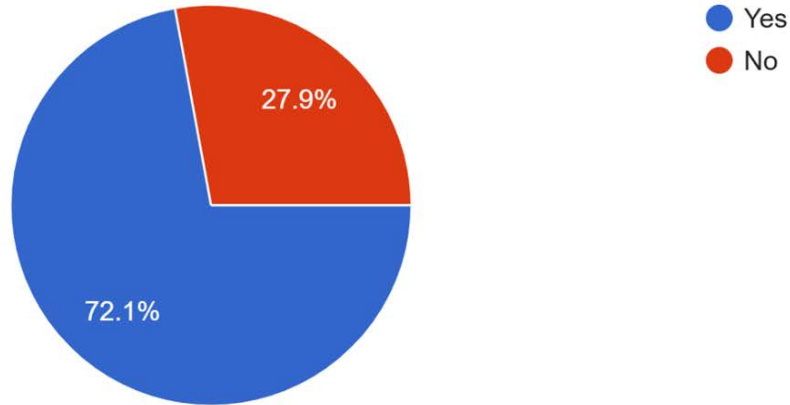

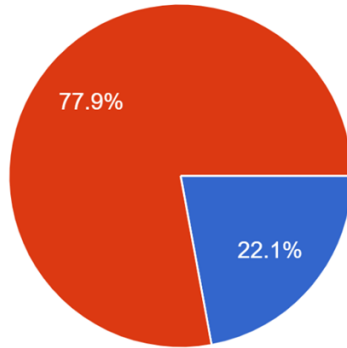
Additional Feedback
