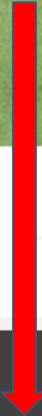

Some Facts About South Callaway R-II Schools Curriculum and the Courses Offered

- ★ South Callaway provides students with **225 Distinct Sets of Teacher-Written Curricula PK-12.**
 - *PK-5 = 90 (core content courses, specials, counseling, & intervention)*
 - *6-12 = 135 (core content courses, specials, counseling, intervention & vocational)*
 - *This includes 8 Dual Credit courses taught by SC teachers and 6 Dual Credit courses offered through ITV.*
 - *All courses are aligned with the Missouri Learning Standards, Missouri-approved vocational standards, ACT standards or national standards in industry, technology, library media, or counseling as appropriate.*
- ★ South Callaway offers **33 Off-Campus Vocational Courses** through Nichols Career Center.
- ★ South Callaway offers an additional **103 Online Courses** in credit recovery, career & technical subjects, and foreign languages to students in 6-12 through the **Edmentum** program.
- ★ **MOCAP Virtual Learning Opportunities** for all grades through an MOU with **Launch and other DESE-Approved vendors.**

In SY 25-26, One New Course is Introduced!

Middle School Basic Sign Language (Elective)

- The Middle School Basic Sign Language course is an elective that may be taken multiple times in grades 6-8. The course is based on Lifeprint Curriculum created by William G. Vicars, EdD, Professor, American Sign Language, which uses a frequency of use model over a list of topics model to teach students to communicate in ASL.
- In the first course, students will learn to communicate about Family, Places, Feelings, & Actions in Unit 1. In Unit 2 they will be able to communicate Colors & Time, Food, Clothes, Things & Animals. Unit 3 includes Questions, Routines, School, Seasons, & Careers.
- Learning Targets are aligned with the Show-Me Curriculum Frameworks & Missouri Learning Standards in World Languages.
- As activities are added, this course will also incorporate local tie-ins with the Missouri School for the Deaf & William Woods University.
