## **Improvements and Accomplishments**

### **CURRICULUM:**

- NWEA reports were analyzed in Grades K-5 to determine strengths, opportunities for improvement, and significant gaps. This information was used to individualize instruction for students.
- Teachers piloted iReady as a new assessment platform to replace NWEA.
- Student Learning Objectives were written to assess student growth throughout the school year. When applicable the NWEA test was administered as part of the SLO (beginning, middle, and end of year).
- Continued Preschool Program with great success. Mrs. Rose Kreidler, lead teacher, with Ms. Autumn Basler as classroom teacher aide.
- Title I Supplemental ELA Teacher, Mrs. Megan Kueker and Ms. Stacy Trollinger provided Tier 3 RTI instruction for students K-5, and collaborated with Ms. Lynette Pfaff, Supplemental ELA Teacher at BLE to facilitate grade level consistencies with interventions and RtI processes.
- Implemented Really Great Reading Phonics program at Grades K-3. The data was analyzed to determine student deficit areas. Teachers were able to provide individualized instruction to students based on their needs.

- Grades 4-5 implemented RGR in small groups as needed to help support students who needed additional phonics instruction.
- Mrs. Jennifer Sutton, Title I Math Instructional Coach, assisted teachers with data analysis - particularly NWEA data, use of best practices, and quality lesson/assessment development.
- Flex grouping was implemented at Grade 4 in math and ELA to differentiate instruction for all students.
- Continued the implementation of the building-wide use of ClassTag as a classroom communication tool. The consistent platform allowed teachers to communicate with families and students easily and effectively. .
- Teachers in Grades K-2 used SeeSaw as the primary online platform for students. Teachers in Grades 3-5 used Google Classroom as the primary online platform.
- The SGE Impact Team was formed to begin working towards a competency-based education platform for instruction.
- Weekly 50 minute collaborative team meetings were utilized by teachers at all grade levels to support collaborative team work on curriculum, instruction and assessment. Weekly minutes were kept and posted.
- Special Education Co-teaching implemented at the 5th grade level.
- RtI (Response to Intervention) continued to be implemented at the kindergarten through fifth grade levels. The data was reviewed every four to six weeks and students were placed in appropriate intervention, on-level instruction, or enrichment groups. Grade level teachers, Special Education teachers, Mrs. Kueker, Ms. Trollinger, Mrs. Aubuchon, Ms. Drury, and Mrs. Ditch provided Tier I, II, and III instruction.
- 4th & 5th grade teachers completed Year 2 LETRS training.
- New hires began Year 1 of LETRS training.
- CARE Teams are held every four to six weeks for all grade levels.
- Dragons' Den was provided as an after school program (\$150/quarterly cost to first student per family, \$100 for each second student in a family, and \$80 for student in a family thereafter)
- The kindergarten team administered Kindergarten Observation Form (KOF).

### **TUTORING SERVICES:**

- A+ tutoring was incorporated into the Dragon's Den program during the entire year.
- Cadet teachers provided support in grades Preschool through Grade 5 classrooms.
