Improvements and Accomplishments

CURRICULUM:

- NWEA reports were analyzed in Grades K-5 to determine strengths, opportunities for improvement, and significant gaps. This information was used to individualize instruction for students.
- Student Learning Objectives were written to assess student growth throughout the school year. When applicable the NWEA test was administered as part of the SLO (beginning, middle, and end of year).
- Continued Preschool Program with great success. Mrs. Nichole Cyr, lead teacher, with Mrs. Jennifer Koetting as classroom teacher aide.
- Title I Supplemental ELA Teacher, Ms. Lynette Pfaff provided Tier 3 RTI instruction for students K-5, and collaborated with Mrs. Tiffany Wolk, Reading Coach at BLE and SGE to facilitate grade level consistencies amongst the two Elementary Buildings.
- We continuously implement the Really Great Reading Phonics program at Grades K-3. Teachers analyzed the data to determine reteaching opportunities. Additional Really Great Reading data is analyzed during RTI meetings to determine Tier II instruction.
- Mrs. Jennifer Sutton, Title I Math Instructional Coach, assisted teachers with data analysis - particularly NWEA data, use of best practices, and quality lesson/assessment development. With the guidance and training Mrs. Sutton provided, all grade levels were able to work on Math Curriculum.
- Flex grouping was implemented at Grade 4 in the area of ELA to work with IDI groups.
- SeeSaw is the primary online platform for students to work virtually in the event of school closure or on AMI days.
- Teachers in Grades 2-5 used Google Classroom as the primary online platform for students to work virtually in the event of school closure or AMI days
- Weekly 50 minute collaborative team meetings were utilized by teachers at all grade levels to support collaborative team work on curriculum, instruction and assessment.
- Special Education Co-teaching implemented in grade 4.

- RtI (Response to Intervention) continued to be implemented at the kindergarten through fifth grade levels. The data was reviewed every four to six weeks and students were placed in appropriate intervention, on-level instruction, or enrichment groups. Grade level teachers, Mrs. Pfaff, Ms. Boyer, and Ms. Trollinger provided Tier I, II, and III instruction.
- Wendy Walker, Makayla Bader, Laura Gegg, Janel Reiss, Aaron Stuppy, and Kellen Basler, completed Year 2 LETRS training along.
- Lauren Bell, Melissa Tisher, and Julie Meyrose began Year 1 of LETRS training.
- CARE Teams are held every four to six weeks for all grade levels.
- Dragons' Den was provided as an after school program (\$150/quarterly cost to first student per family, \$100 for each second student in a family, and \$80 for student in a family thereafter) - Starting enrollment 62, ending enrollment 48.
- Ashley Grien, Kim Brown, Kristi Byington, Paige Naeger, Aaron Stuppy, and Christina Guilford are our Impact Team members. They visited various schools in Liberty School District to gain an understanding of Competency Based Learning. They also attended training days with Jeanette Westfall to learn more about CBL.
- Nichole Cyr, Ashley Grein, Ashley Gettinger, and Katie Gettinger attended the Young Years Conference. They brought back many great ideas and resources.
- The Tier II Reflection Room has had a great start. We had much success with Mrs. Rayoum running the room with the assistance of Ashtin Smith.
- First grade team met with SGE First Grade Team and finished creating their Standards Based Report Card.
- Second Grade team met with SGE Second Grade Team and began working on creating a Standards Based Report Card.
