- **Substituting Products/Emergency Situations:** All modifications will be taken into consideration. Domino's will do its best to accommodate changes that exceed these guidelines or occur in emergency situations. If Whole Grain dough is not available, Domino's will consult with the District to see if the Retail Product can be utilized in urgent circumstances.
- **Nonconforming Products:** If the contractor supplies the district with products that do not meet the specifications of the National School Lunch Program (NSLP), are not reimbursable under this program, and are not served during extraordinary or emergency circumstances, the contractor must:

a. Refund the full purchase price for all nonconforming products provided.

b. Compensate the district for the total amount of reimbursement lost due to the sale of these nonconforming and non-reimbursable items as part of the daily lunch service.

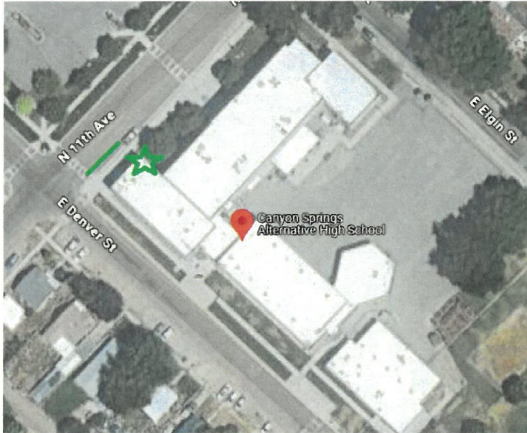


