

# WCPSS 2025-26 Facility Utilization Report: Final Published Report\*

*\*based on PMR-2 released November 25, 2025*

## Introduction:

Each year, the Facility Utilization Report (FUR) provides a snapshot of how school buildings and learning spaces are used across the district. This report is a critical tool for school and district leaders to understand utilization levels, identify potential crowding concerns, and develop future planning scenarios.

This version, known as the **Final Published Report\***, reflects student enrollment and official school capacity for the **2025-26 school year**. It is based on our most current student data, specifically the second month of school (PMR-2) Average Daily Membership (ADM). This PMR-2 ADM represents the official, verified count of students enrolled and attending school, providing a reliable, point-in-time view of current year utilization.

While the Projected FUR published earlier in the year provided valuable information for initial planning, the Final Published FUR offers the definitive measure used for capacity decisions and informs long-range planning.

**Terms & Definitions:** To help interpret the data in the report, here are some key terms...

- **Average Daily Membership (ADM):** The average number of students enrolled and actively attending school each day over a given month. This is calculated by dividing the total number of student membership days (excluding those with attendance violations) by the number of school days in the month.
- **Capacity:** The maximum number of students a school can effectively serve based on the district's capacity models, which considers classroom space, staffing, and program needs.
- **Capacity Model:** A framework that defines how many students a school can accommodate based on the number and types of classrooms available. It outlines the planned use of each classroom within the brick-and-mortar building, ensuring space is allocated efficiently to support student learning and program needs.
- **Enrollment:** The total number of students officially registered at a school, regardless of their attendance patterns.
- **Facility Utilization Report (FUR):** An annual report that details how school buildings and spaces are being used, including student enrollment, building capacity, the use of trailers, and how specialized programs impact available space.
- **Flex Capacity:** Additional, flexible capacity incorporated into the brick-and-mortar building that can be used to accommodate enrollment above and beyond the stated building capacity.

- **Principals' Monthly Report (PMR):** A monthly report that tracks school enrollment data, including ADM calculations, to help monitor student attendance trends.
- **PMR-2:** The Principals' Monthly Report for Month 2, a key data point used for planning and funding decisions.
- **Trailers (Mobile Units or Modular Classrooms):** Temporary or semi-permanent classroom spaces placed on a school campus to accommodate student enrollment beyond the capacity of the brick-and-mortar building.
- **Utilization:** A measure of how a school's available space is being used compared to its capacity. This helps determine whether a school is over-enrolled, underutilized, or operating at an optimal level.

- Schools:** The official school name and grade levels served. Abbreviations include:
  - ES: Elementary School
  - MS: Middle School
  - HS: High School
  - (M-T): Multi-Track Year-Round
  - (S-T): Single-Track Year-Round
- PMR 2:** The ADM calculation for month 2 for each school. Grade levels include:
  - ES: Grades K-5
  - MS: Grades 6-8
  - HS: Grades 9-12 (Grades 9-13 for Early Colleges)

4. **School Building Capacity:** The number of students a school can accommodate based on the capacity model, which considers the number and types of classrooms in the main school building, as well as the operating calendar for the school.
5. **Capacity Trailers and/or Flex Capacity:** The number of temporary or flexible-use classrooms (such as trailers or modular units) that provide additional space for students beyond the main school building.
6. **Total Campus Capacity:** The overall student capacity of a school, calculated by adding the School Building Capacity and any additional space from Capacity Trailers and/or Flex Capacity.
7. **Total Campus Crowding % (with Trailers and/or Flex Capacity):** A measure of how full a school is, calculated by dividing the PMR-2 Enrollment by the Total Campus Capacity and expressed as a percentage.
8. **Non-Capacity & Retired Trailers:** The number of trailers on campus that are either not used for student capacity (such as storage or office space) or have been retired from use.
9. **Color Key:** A visual legend explaining the color coding used in the Code and School columns. Colors indicate specific statuses, such as new construction, renovation, enrollment caps, and other important designations.
