~~The Guilford County Board of Education is committed to the involvement of teachers in the decision-making process, and the Teacher Advisory Council (TAC) is one mechanism for encouraging such involvement. The purpose of the TAC is to serve as a liaison between teachers, schools, and central office administrators in order to identify, express, and resolve system-wide concerns.~~

~~The Superintendent or designee will meet with the TAC representatives on a regularly scheduled basis, and a calendar of meeting dates will be established. The meetings will be scheduled for the Board Room, in the Eugene Street Administration Building.~~

~~The Superintendent will develop a process for selecting TAC membership, to be completed by June 1st of each year. After the selection process is complete, the names of the TAC representatives will be submitted to the Superintendent's designee. Questions that are to be addressed during the meetings should be submitted in writing to the Superintendent's designee.~~
