RE: **2023-24 Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) Highlights**

I. BACKGROUND

The State of California requires every school district to write a Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) for spending State-funded monetary allocations for education. The LCAP describes how the District will meet its annual goals for students, which should reflect both State requirements and local priorities. The LCAP is designed to address a set of standardized, measurable goals, for the purpose of improving conditions of learning, pupil outcomes, and engagement of staff, students, and community members. The LCAP must be adopted by local School Boards by July 1 and reviewed annually.

The School Board adopted the following three goals for Piedmont Unified for the 2021-24 LCAP:

Goal 1: All students and staff will feel physically and emotionally safe and part of a caring and inclusive community.

Goal 2: All students will engage in relevant learning experiences that foster life-long curiosity, creativity, collaboration, critical thinking, communication, and responsible citizenship.

Goal 3: Teachers and staff, with district partners, will ensure an outstanding educational experience for every student through collaboration, innovation, and professional growth.

PUSD presented updates on the 2022-23 action items at several Board meetings throughout the year, and the public gave feedback in those meetings.

2023-24 LCAP Highlights

The 2023-24 LCAP is the district's strategic plan for the third year of the current 3-year LCAP cycle. Very few changes are being recommended for year 3.
