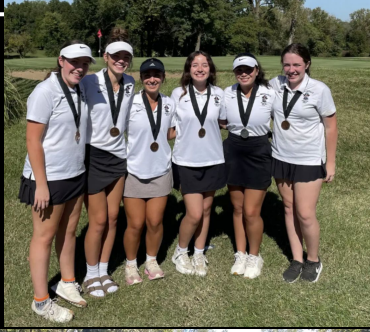

 - Offerings equal or surpass all suburban conference schools
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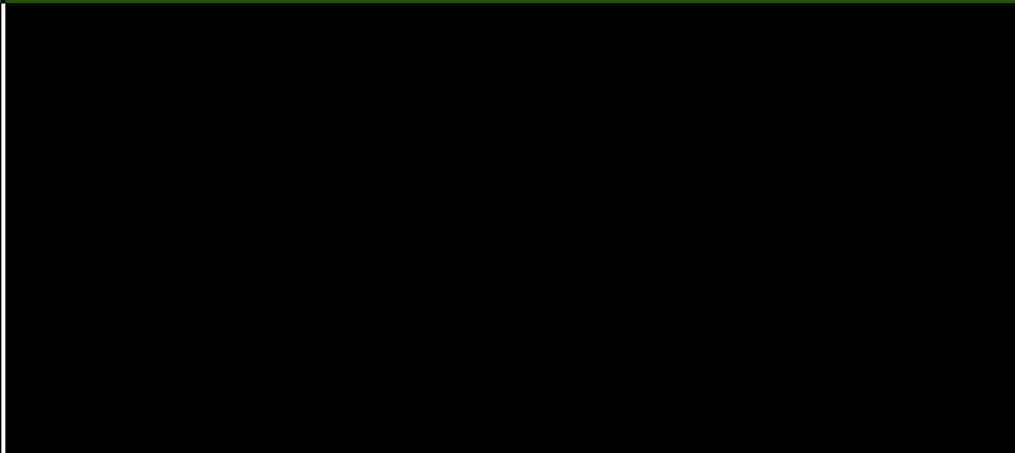

 - Cross Country at Tiemeyer Park



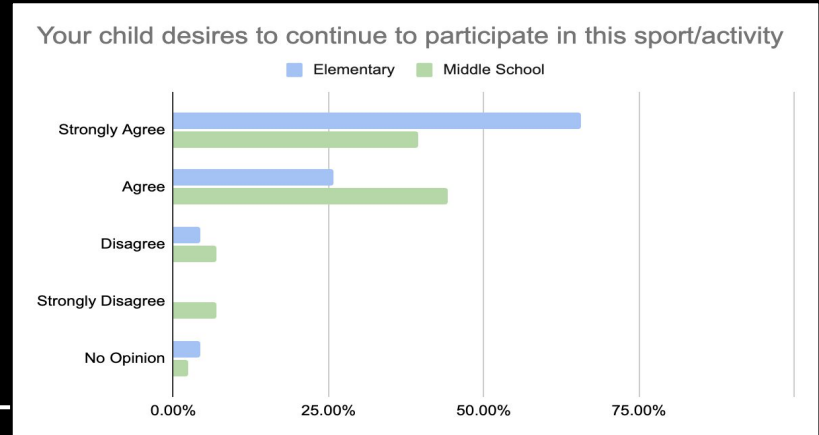
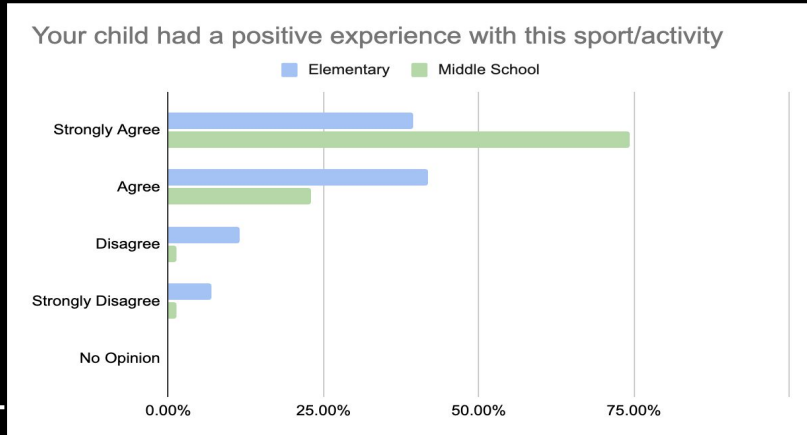
K-8 ATHLETICS & ACTIVITIES
