Whereupon, the President declared the resolution duly adopted as follows:

RESOLUTION FOR A CONVEYANCE OF REAL PROPERTY

WHEREAS, pursuant to notice published as required by law, the Board of Directors of the Iowa City Community School District on the 24th day of March, 2026 held a hearing on the proposal to convey an interest in real property and the extent of objections received from residents or property owners as to said proposed transaction has been fully considered; and, accordingly the following action is now considered to be in the best interests of the District and residents thereof:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF THE IOWA CITY COMMUNITY SCHOOL DISTRICT:

Section 1. That the real property described herein shall be conveyed by the District to City of Hills for \$450,000.00 and other good and valuable consideration. Conveyance by the District shall be by Deed without Warranty.

Section 2. The Board President and Secretary are authorized to sign all conveyance documents for the real property described herein.

Section 3. The Board President, Secretary, Superintendent, and administrative officers of the District are authorized to take all actions necessary to complete the above-described transaction, including execution of ancillary documents.

Section 4. The real property is locally known as 301 W. Main St., Hills, IA , and is legally described as follows:

A parcel of land in Sec. 22, Twp. 78N., R. 6 West of the 5th P.M., in the Town of Hills, Iowa, described as follows: Commencing at

the Northwest corner of said Sec. 22; thence on an assumed bearing due South along centerline of U.S. Highway #218, 124.58 feet; thence North 89 degrees 15 minutes 40 seconds East 283.00 feet along centerline of Main Street; thence South 0 degrees 58 minutes 40 seconds East 33.00 feet to the point of beginning; thence South 0 degrees 58 minutes 40 seconds East 581.05 feet; thence North 89 degrees 15 minutes 20 seconds east 515.00 feet; thence North 0 degrees 58 minutes 40 seconds West 581.00 feet; thence South 89 degrees 15 minutes 40 seconds West 515.00 feet to the point of beginning. Said parcel contains 6 .87 acres, more or less.
