



TRANSITIONAL INTER-DISTRICT TRANSPORTATION AGREEMENT

According to the McKinney Vento Act, 722 (g)(1)(J)(iii), the State and its local educational agencies will adopt policies and practices to ensure that transportation is provided, at the request of the parent or guardian (or in the case of an unaccompanied youth, the liaison), to and from the school of origin, as determined in paragraph (3)(A), in accordance with the following, as applicable:

- I. If the homeless child or youth continues to live in the area served by the local educational agency in which the District/School of Origin is located, the child's or youth's transportation to and from the school of origin shall be provided or arranged by the local educational agency in which the school of origin is located.
- II. If the homeless child's or youth's living arrangements in the area served by the local educational agency of origin terminate and the child or youth, though continuing his or her education in the school of origin, begins living in an area served by another local educational agency, the local educational agency of origin and the local educational agency in which the homeless child or youth is living (District of Residence) shall agree upon a method to apportion the responsibility and costs for providing the child with transportation to and from the school of origin. If the local educational agencies are unable to agree upon such a method, the responsibility and costs for transportation shall be shared equally.

All Participants, signing this agreement, agree that:

1. The term of this agreement will begin immediately upon signing and will continue until termination is initiated by either school district.
2. The District of Origin and the District of Residence will share the cost of transportation on a 50/50 basis for any students who remain in their school of origin. For each student impacted, individual transportation plans will be developed and managed by the District of Origin McKinney-Vento Liaison in partnership with the District of Residence McKinney-Vento Liaison.
3. The district where the student is currently enrolled/attending agrees to arrange the transportation and monitor billing. The District of Origin will invoice the District of Residence for combined costs for all students on a monthly basis, based upon the transportation costs table (updated annually) and student attendance.
4. The District of Origin will collaborate with the District of Residence to discuss arrangements involving various methods of transportation in order to determine the most cost-effective and safe means of transportation.
5. The District of Origin will comply with McKinney-Vento verification and monitoring of eligibility of students at the start of every academic year.
6. Each district has established contacts for meeting McKinney-Vento educational needs of students. These Liaisons have the ability to approve transportation arrangements within each district. The districts below have named specific contacts as appropriate individuals to contact when a family is in transition.
