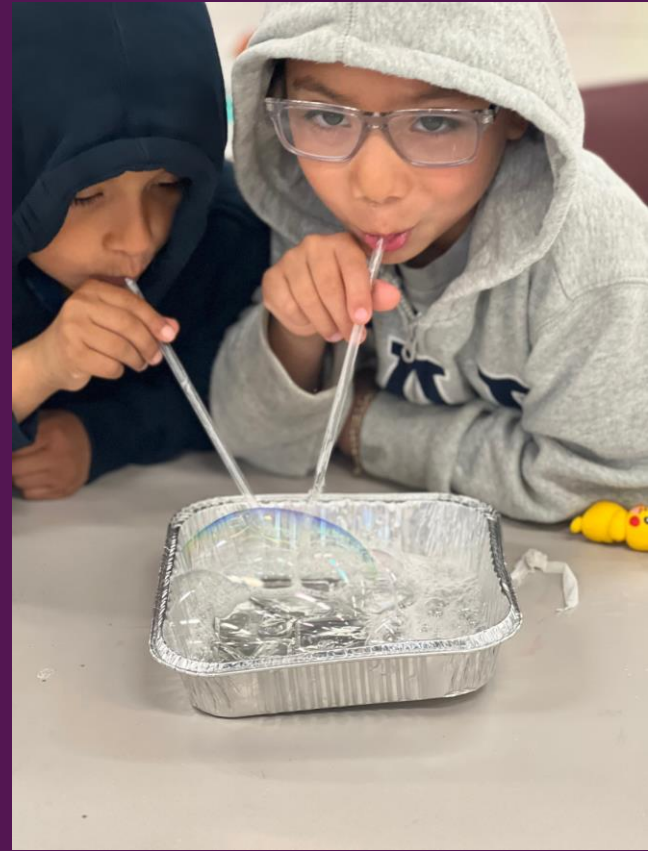
Intent

Intent - Cont'd

- Students in grades TK-6
- Unduplicated students:
 - English Learner
 - Free/Reduced Lunch
 - Foster Youth
- Provide access to any unduplicated student whose parent requests placement



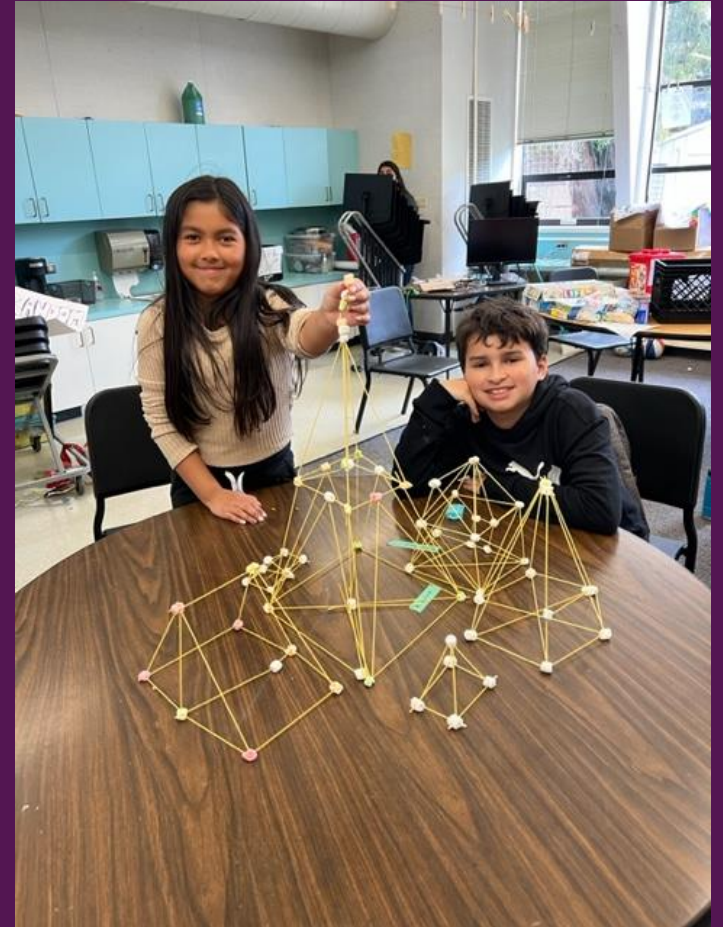
Requirements

- Core Day + Expanded Learning = Nine Hours
- At least 30 non-school days (no less than nine hours)
- Grades TK/K: 10:1 ratio
Grades 1-6: 20:1 ratio



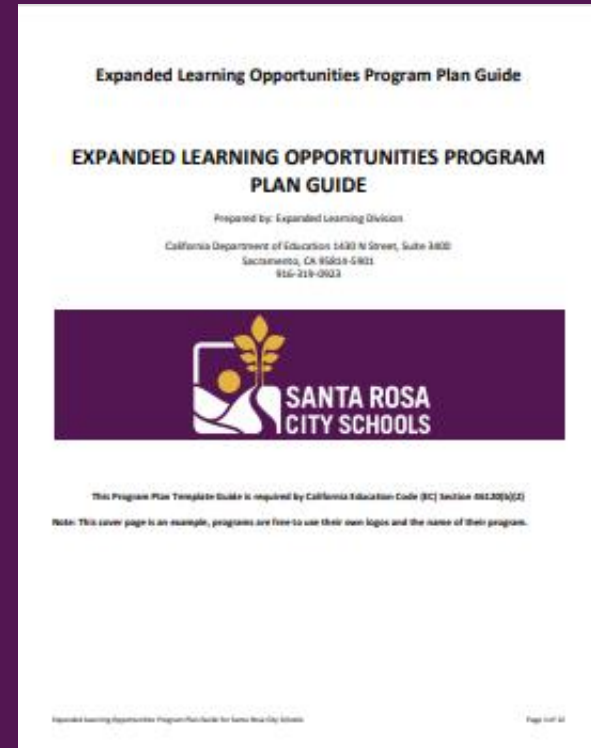
Requirements - Cont'd
