Star assessments are computer-adaptive and give educators accurate, reliable, and valid data to guide instructional decision-making.



Frequency

The Star assessments are given three times a year at the beginning, middle, and end of the school year.

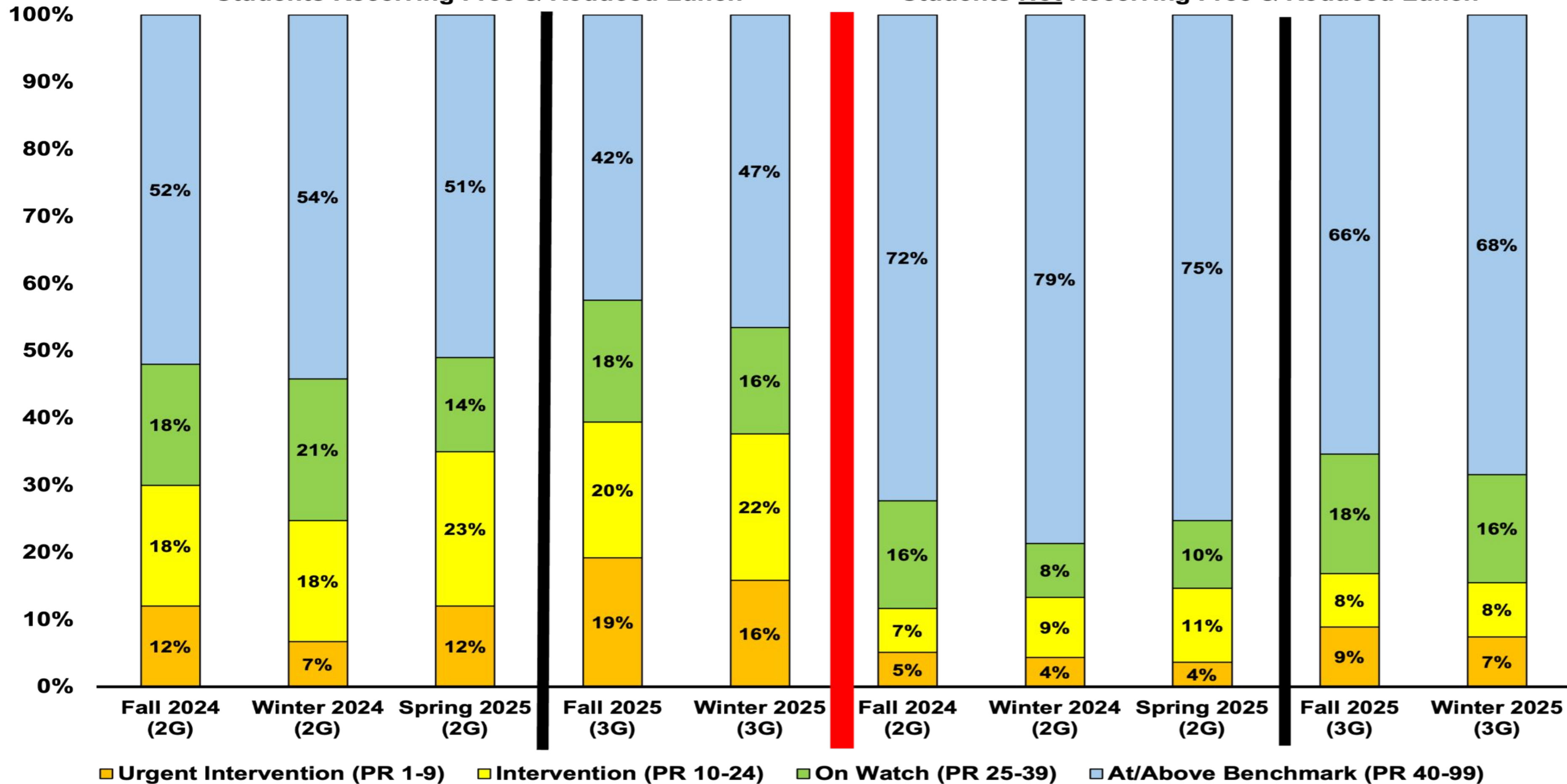

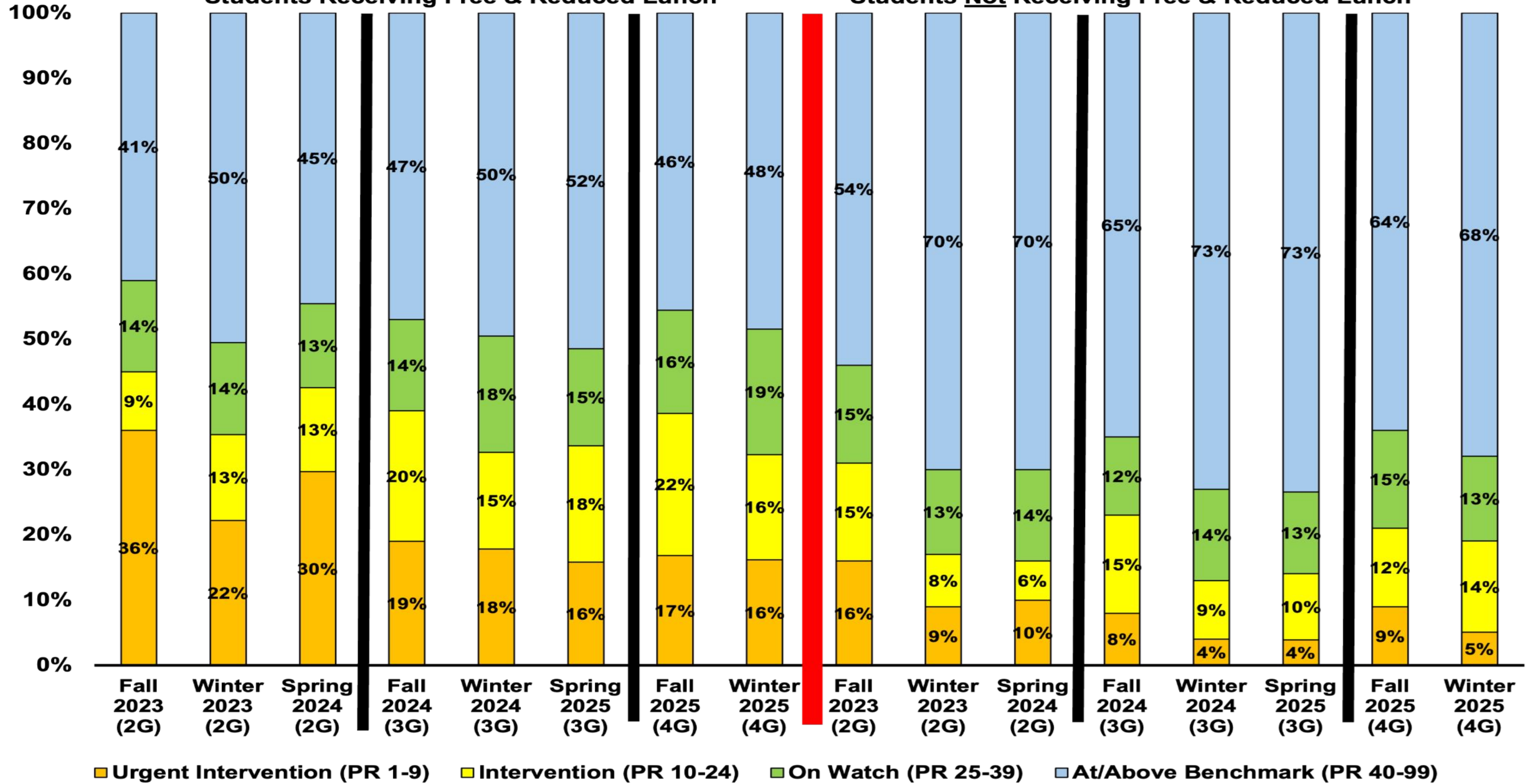

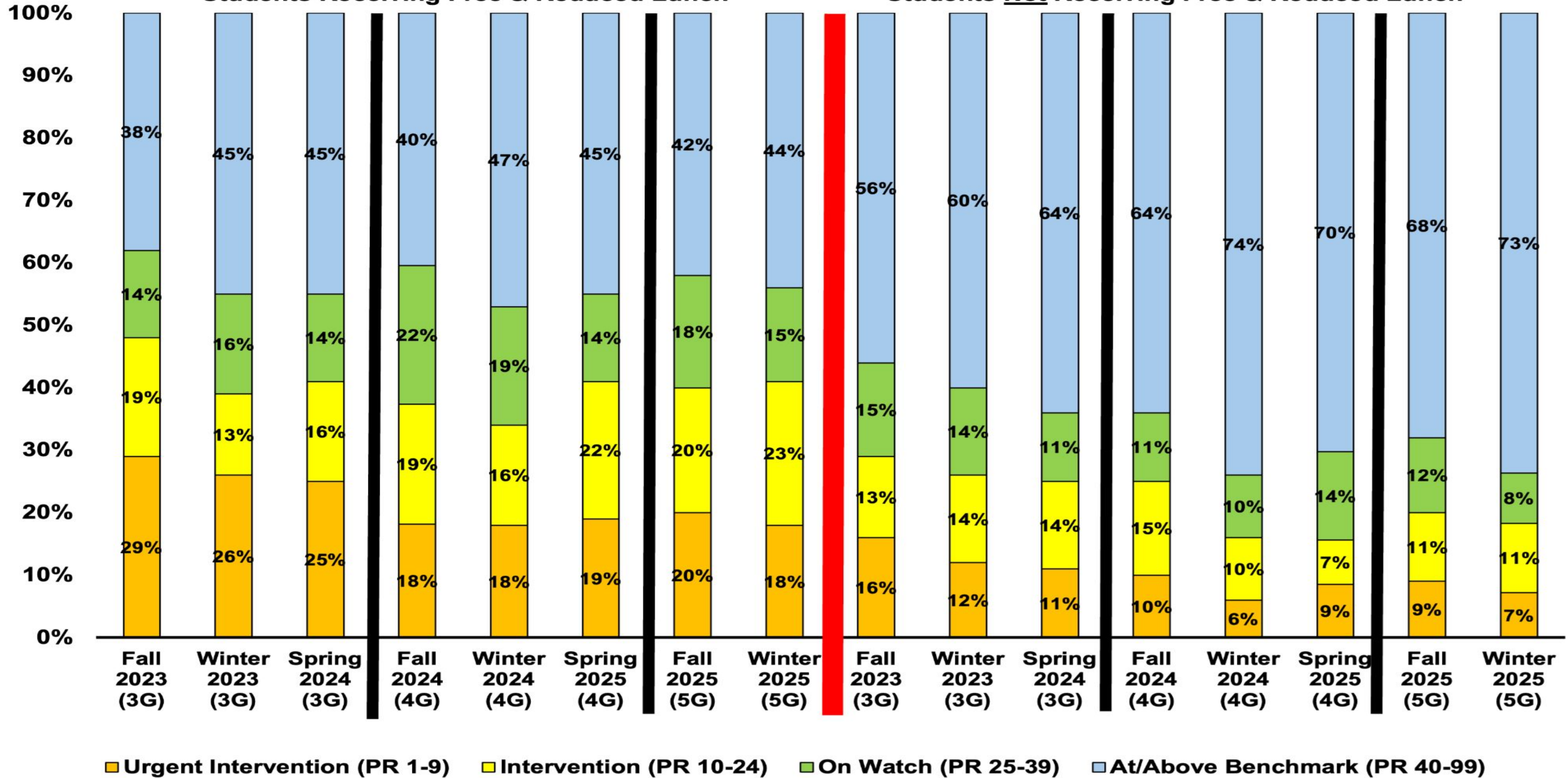

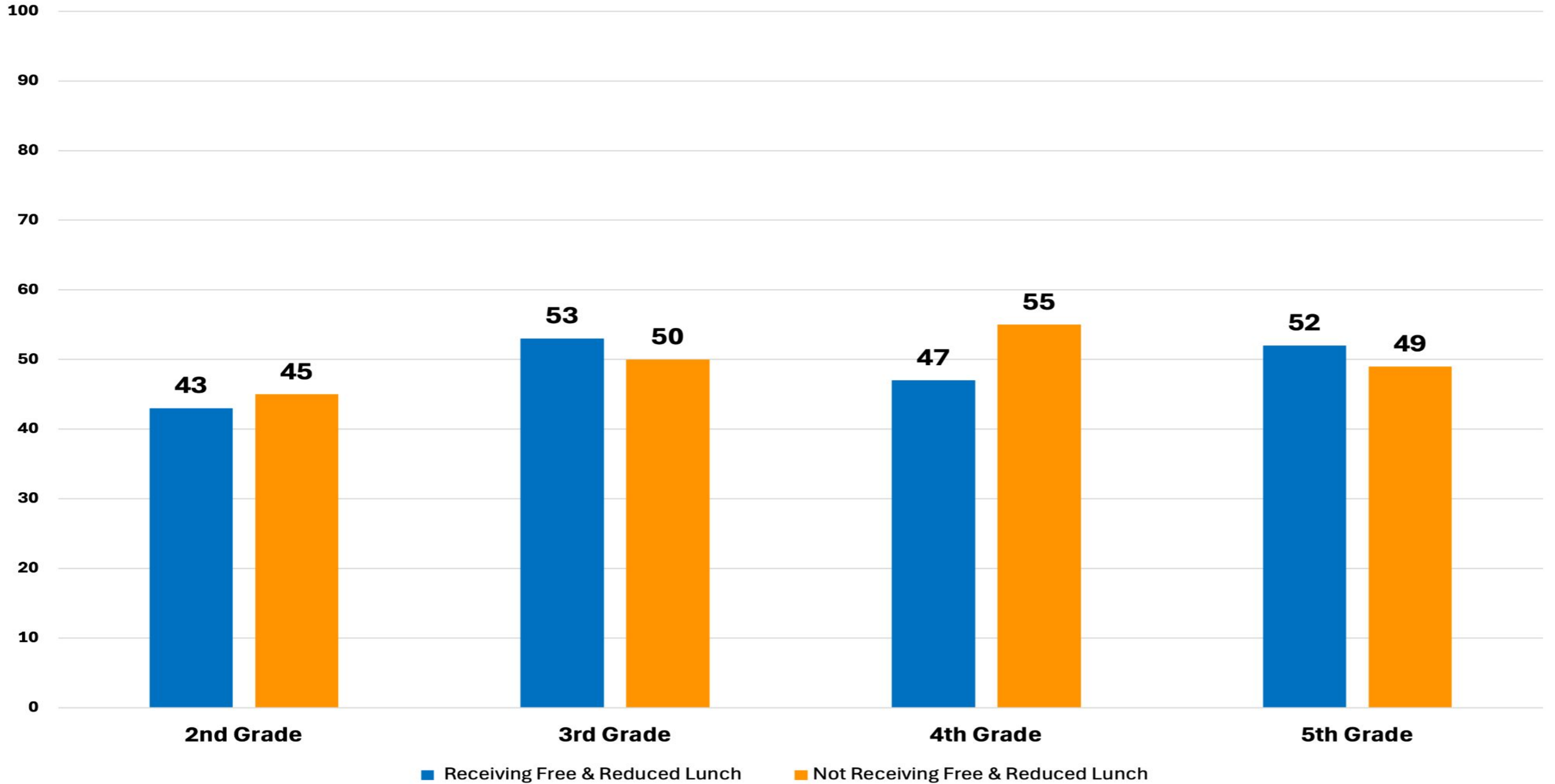

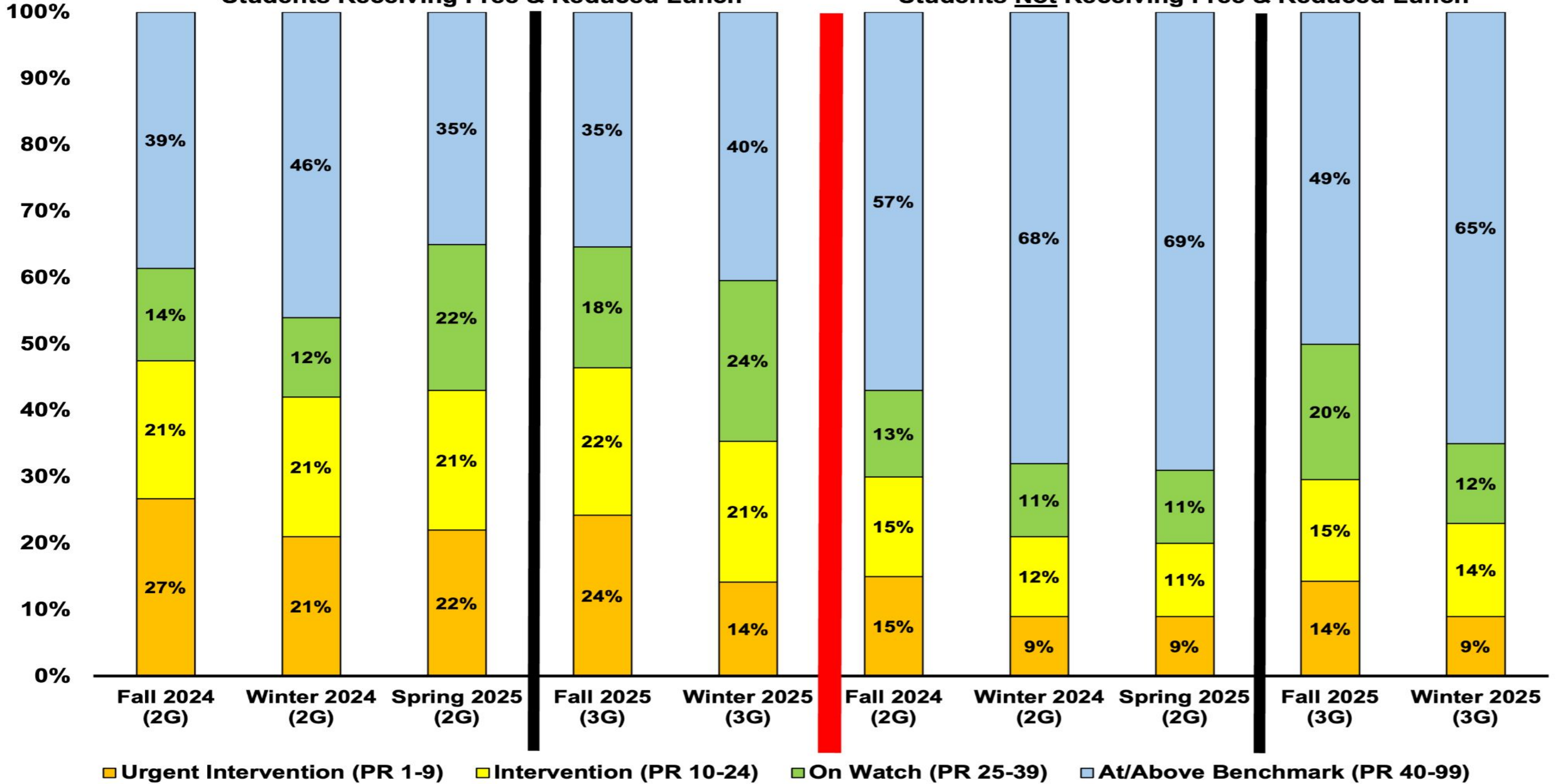
Fall to Spring Student Growth Percentile by Grade & Group

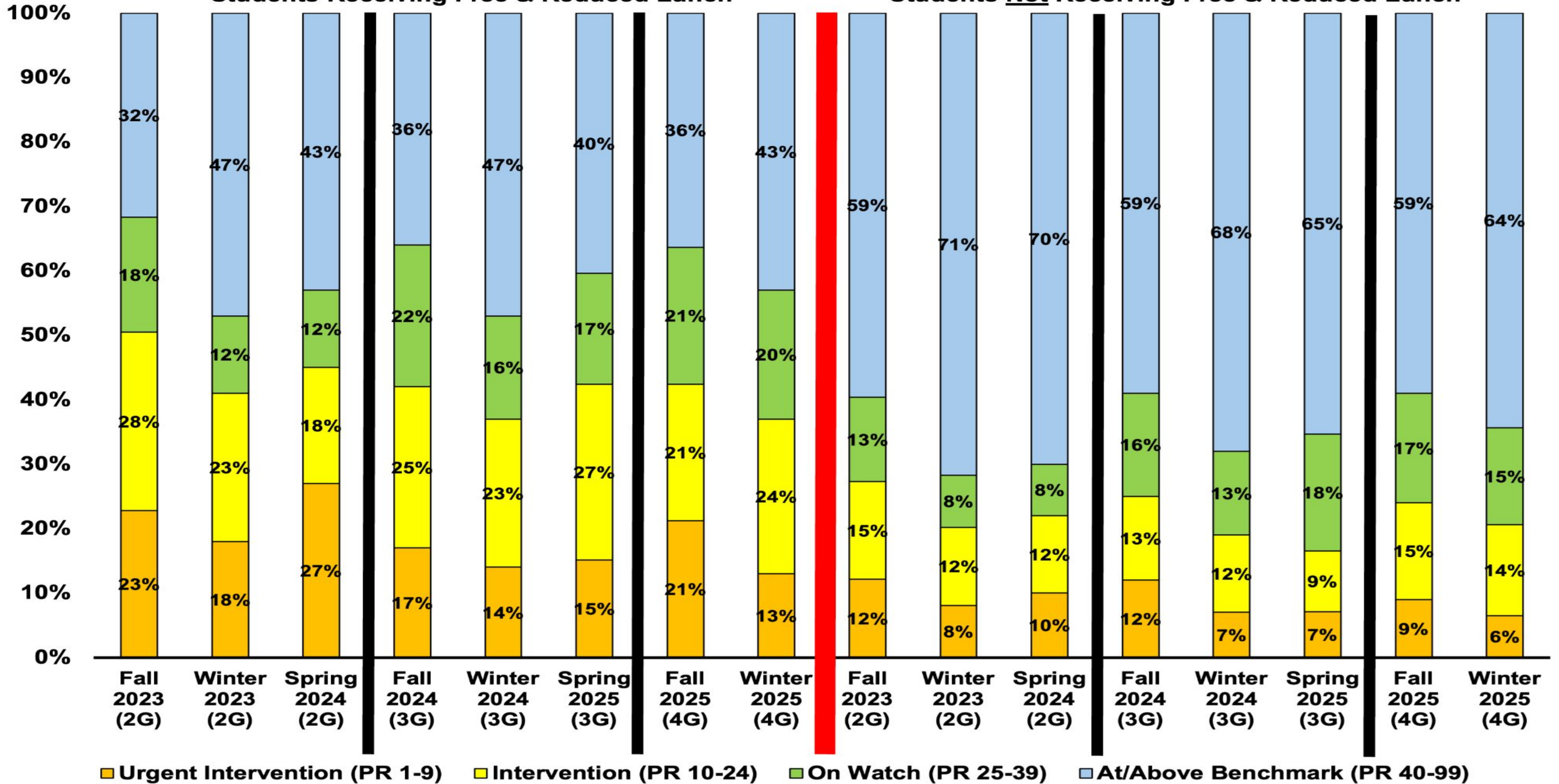

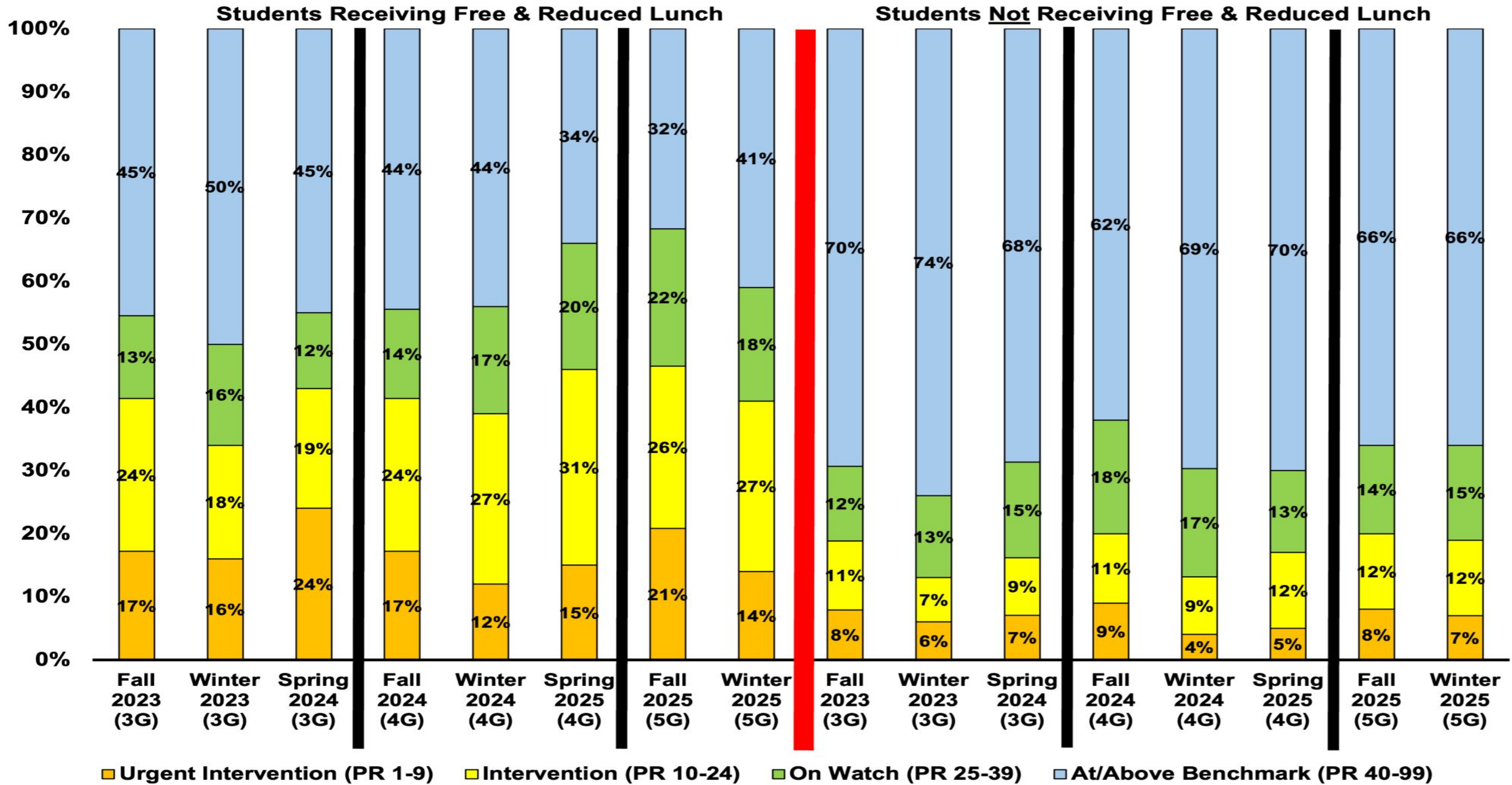
4th Grade Star Math

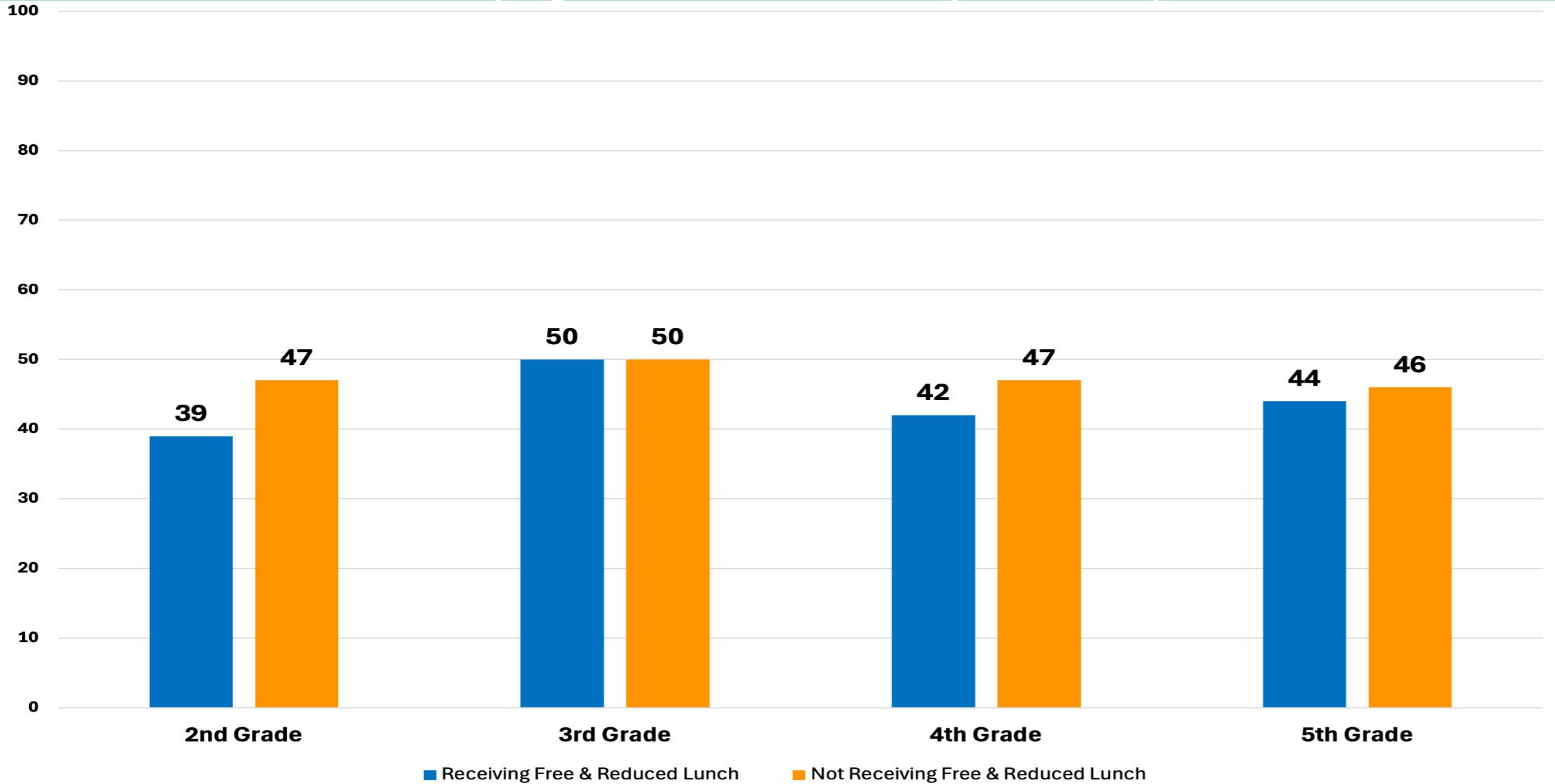


5th Grade Star Math
