SCOPE will utilize School/District enrollment and Free and Reduced Lunch counts certified on the CALPADS Fall 1 reporting for the E-Rate application. Additionally, School/District will supply a signed Form 479 to certify CIPA compliance. The Safe School Ambassadors (SSA) program is an evidence-based program which harnesses the power that students have to prevent & stop bullying and mistreatment among other students on campus. This program is considered an SEL program with a student centered model which educates students on the skills needed to reduce bullying on their school campus.		Community Matters is offering Herbert Slater Middle School 2 days of on-site training for 35-40 NEW Safe School Ambassadors and 5-7 adults. On Day 2, schools may add up to 12 previously trained veteran Ambassadors and Program Adults. (1:6 adult to student ratio for each day). Community Matters will provide materials for all training participants including post training support for implementation of the the program. They will also provide 2 hours of program implementation support by phone, web and email.			(Community Matters Survey) 80% of trained Ambassadors will report a gain in confidence and competence in their ability to intervene and speak up when they witness bullying, harassment and cyber-bullying in their school. In addition, Montgomery High School will see a 10% decrease in the most common suspendable offenses including fighting, harassment or bullying.
