Universal design for learning (UDL) is a teaching approach that works to accommodate the needs and abilities of all learners and eliminates unnecessary hurdles in the learning process. Our goal is to bring these practices to Biella Elementary through a partnership with SCOE with a small cohort who will dive deeper into these best practices. Analyze student data, and work together to continue building inclusivity at Biella.



EDUCATION

Teams will build a shared understanding and common language related to Universal Design for Learning through two full day learning sessions. These sessions will take place in January and February, with specific dates to be determined.

PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

Teams participate in ongoing professional learning that allows for deeper exploration and application of UDL concepts. These monthly workshops are 2 hours per month, and will occur after contract hours. The grant will cover team member compensation as needed

ACTION

Teams will put what they learn into action, and gather evidence of how implementation of UDL is impacting students' learning. This will include experiences such as instructional rounds and lesson design study.
