**RESOLUTION FINDING LATHROP CONSTRUCTION ASSOCIATES, INC. AS
THE BEST VALUE TO THE SCHOOL DISTRICT AND APPROVING AWARD OF THE
LEASE-LEASEBACK AGREEMENT WITH LATHROP CONSTRUCTION
ASSOCIATES, INC.**

WHEREAS, the Tamalpais Union High School District (“District”) is currently undertaking a project known as the Tamalpais High School Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts and Mathematics (STEAM) Building Replacement Project (“Project”); and

WHEREAS, on October 10, 2023, the District’s Board of Trustees (“Board”) adopted Resolution 23-05, regarding required procedures and guidelines (“Best Value Methodology”) for evaluating the qualifications of proposers that ensure the best value selections by the District are conducted in a fair and impartial manner pursuant to Education Code section 17406; and

WHEREAS, the District incorporated the Best Value Methodology in a Request for Qualifications and Proposals (RFQ/P #95) for the Project, identifying evaluation criteria, which was advertised in a local periodical/newspaper and in local construction trades once a week for two weeks; and

WHEREAS, a Selection Committee comprised of District staff and District consultants, reviewed proposals for the Project submitted in response to RFQ/P #95 in accordance with the adopted Best Value Methodology and taking into consideration the proposers’ demonstrated competence and professional qualifications necessary for the satisfactory performance of the services required; and

WHEREAS, after consideration of all of the proposals and interviews and based upon the information provided by the prospective contractors, the District evaluated and the Board hereby approves award of the Site Lease and Facilities Lease (“Lease-Leaseback Agreement”) to Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc., who was the highest ranked respondent according to the adopted Best Value Methodology, for the Project; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc. has been prequalified pursuant to Public Contract Code section 20111.6; and

WHEREAS, Education Code section 17406 provides that the school district governing board shall issue a written decision supporting its contract award and stating the basis of the award; and

WHEREAS, attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”** to this Resolution is the evaluation findings of Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc. supporting the Board’s award of the Lease-Leaseback Agreement to Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc.

THEREFORE, IT IS RESOLVED that the Board of Trustees of the Tamalpais Union High School District hereby determines, and finds the following:

Section 1. That the foregoing recitals and the findings are true.

Section 2. That the District complied with the procedure set forth in Education Code section 17406, the Best Value Methodology adopted by the District and the Request for Qualifications and Proposals issued by the District.

Section 3. That Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc. provided the proposal with the best value to the District, taking into consideration the proposer's demonstrated competence and professional qualifications necessary for the satisfactory performance of the services required.

Section 4. That, based on the foregoing, it is in the best interest of the District to award the Lease-Leaseback Agreement to Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc. for the Project.

Section 5. That the Superintendent, or designees, are authorized to enter into the Lease-Leaseback Agreement with Lathrop Construction Associates, Inc., to negotiate and finalize the Guaranteed Maximum Price (GMP) and any amendments, and to take any and all actions that are necessary to carry out, give effect to and comply with the terms and intent of this Resolution.

**FINDINGS REGARDING THE AWARD OF THE LEASE-LEASEBACK AGREEMENT
FOR TAMALPAIS HIGH SCHOOL STEAM BUILDING REPLACEMENT PROJECT**

WHEREAS, Lathrop received a “*Pass*” designation for Conflict of Interest; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received a “*Pass*” designation for Safety; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received a “*Pass*” designation for Form of Agreement; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received 25 out of 26 points for Technical Expertise; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received 18 out of 22 points for Interview; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received 21 out of 22 points for Price Points; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received 14 out of 16 points for Staffing; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received 6 out of 7 points for Schedule/Liquidated Damages; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop received 7 out of 7 points for Claims/Litigation; and

WHEREAS, Lathrop’s overall combined score was **91** out of **100** points, based on RFQ/P #95 evaluation criteria, which was the greatest number of points in accordance with the methodology described in RFQ/P #95, and was ranked as the “*Best Value*” to the District out of ten (10) proposals submitted.
