NCCWB will be conducting a pre/post evaluation to measure students' knowledge of, attitudes toward, and intentions to use vape pens. Additionally they will conduct a 3, 6, and 12 month survey after participating in the curriculum to determine if the actual use of vape pens has decreased. Further evidence will be a reduction of suspensions for possessions of vape pens.
