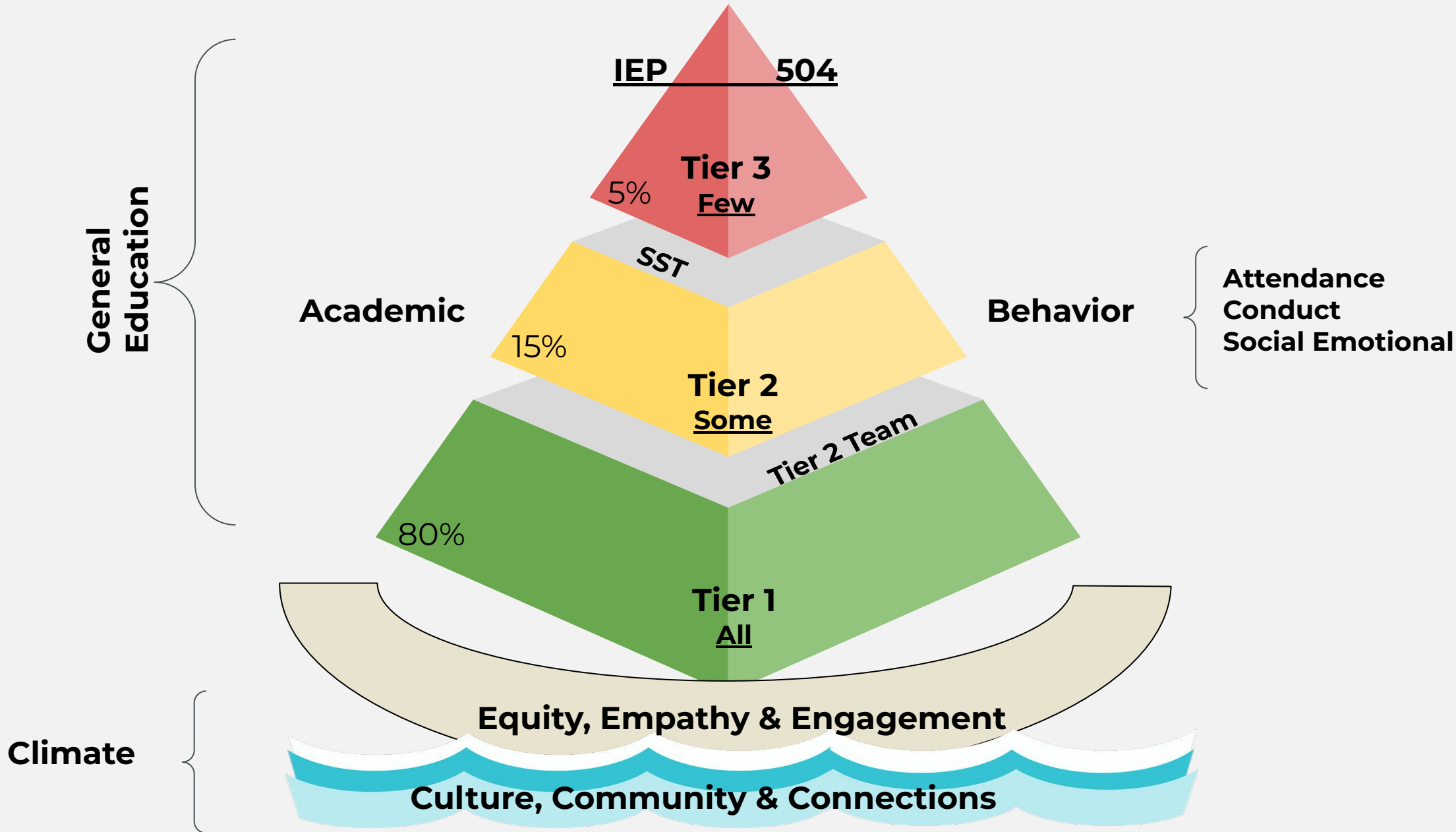


**The MTSS Intervention Counselor at the middle school level is a new position this school year. The Santa Rosa and Comstock Middle School position is still vacant.*

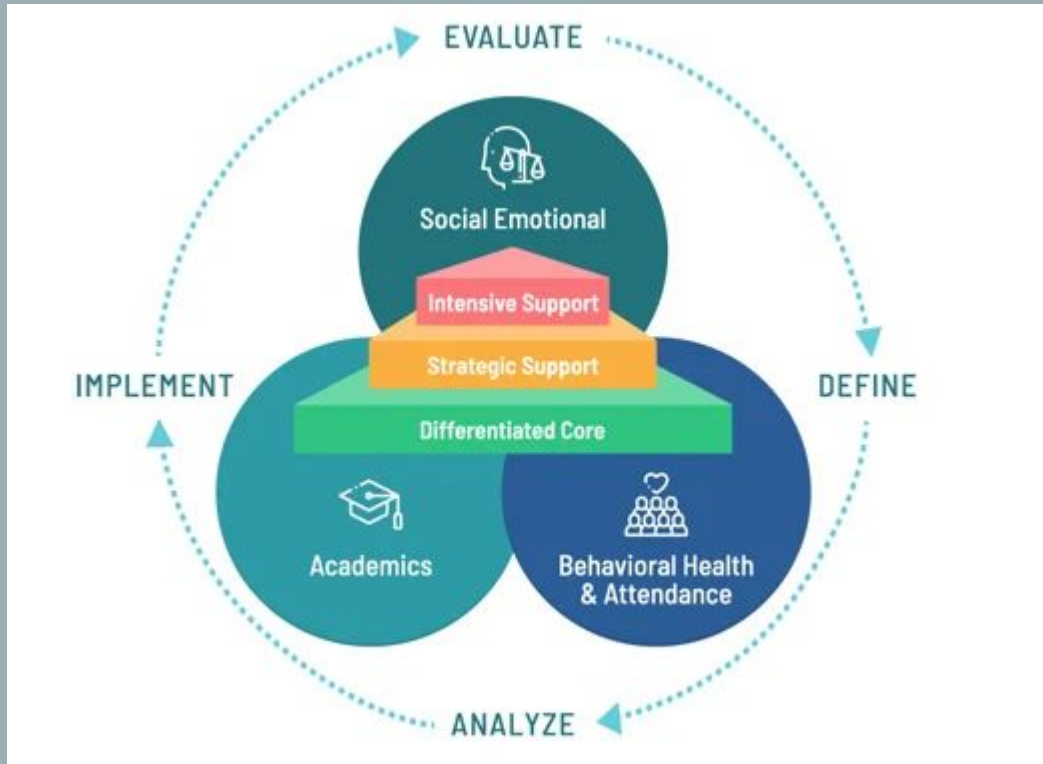
WHAT IS THE ROLE OF A





YOUTH TRUTH SURVEY

GRADES 7-12, JANUARY 2024

Engagement: The degree to which students perceive themselves as engaged with their school and their education.

Relationships: The degree to which students feel they receive support and personal attention from their teachers.

Culture: The degree to which students believe that their school fosters a culture of respect and fairness.

Percent Change refers to the percentage point difference between the current survey round's and the most recent previous survey round's percent positives. For example, a 45% followed by a +3 Percent Change, indicates that the previous survey round's percent positive was 42%.

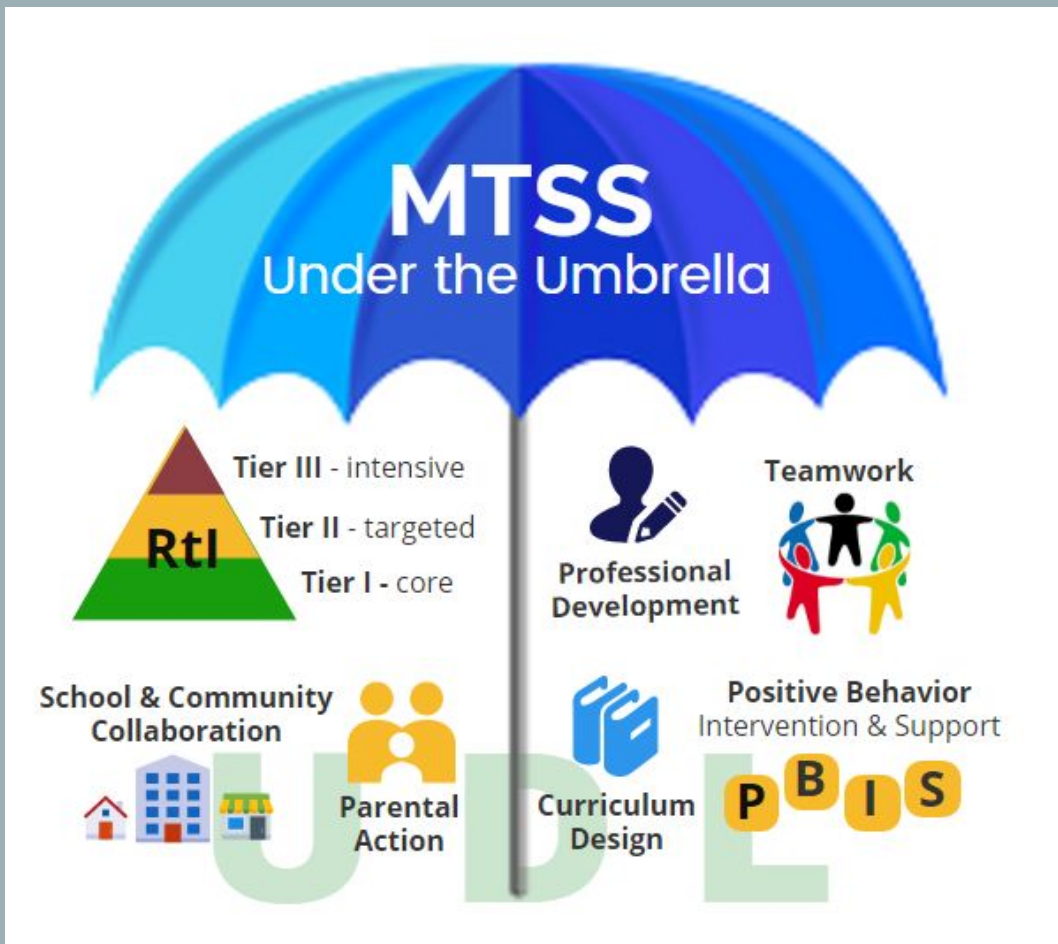
