A second MOU will be drafted for the 2024-2025 school year.		Many of the students who are attending the Regional DHH program at Hidden Valley are profoundly deaf and use ASL as their primary or only mode of communication. Their families and the DHH staff (teachers and instructional assistants) need to learn and/or increase their ASL skills to better meet the communication, educational, and social-emotional needs of the students. The DHH students will also benefit from weekly ASL instruction provided by SRJC's ASL faculty member. There will be 3 separate classes offered, weekly, for students, families, and DHH staff.
