

School-Based Therapist Clinical Supervision Stipend

STIPEND DESCRIPTION

The Wellness and Engagement Department and Special Education department employs School-Based Therapists (SBT) who provide mental health services throughout the school district. When the district hires associate therapists and social workers it is necessary to provide them clinical supervision so they can practice legally. When Licensed SBTs are needed to provide clinical supervision they will be eligible for a Stipend.

In order to qualify for the full stipend SBTs should have a full caseload of 8-10 supervisees. Staff who are serving as Clinical Supervisors are responsible for ensuring that all supervisees are providing quality care that meets the standard of care for mental health services. Clinical supervisors are responsible for all paperwork and experience verification of supervisees. As a clinical supervisor, staff also represent the department at various district and site meetings or events. Clinical supervisors also provide training to staff and work closely with their directors to ensure that training needs are met.

It is expected that this position will require at least 10 hours per week of supervision including group, triadic, and individual supervision. In addition to providing Clinical Supervision stipend recipients will serve as departmental leads who oversee and ensure program effectiveness and quality assurance.

Organize, schedule, and facilitate monthly department/team meetings, with an agenda coordinated in advance and meeting minutes shared with team members and the Director to revisit/review.

Staff who supervise under 5 associates will receive ½ (HALF) stipend and staff who supervise 6-10 associates will receive the full amount.
