This addendum continues to provide professional development and teacher training to support staff in effective usage as a resource and tool for student achievement.</p>			<p>All teachers in grades 3-12 have access to the Newsela platform. Teachers grades 3-6, have articles from Newsela embedded into the elementary CCD units lessons. 1)Teacher usage in grades 3-6 has increased from the average of 29 teachers to 37.
