

**AMENDMENT No. 1 TO
AGREEMENT FOR SCHOOL-BASED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES**

This Amendment to Agreement For School-Based Mental Health Services (“Amendment”) is made and entered into between San José Unified School District (“District”) and Pacific Clinics (“Firm”) (collectively “Parties”; “Party” shall refer to Firm and/or District).

RECITALS

- A. WHEREAS, Firm and District entered into a written Agreement for School-Based Mental Health Services on August 9, 2024, identified as (“Agreement”):
- B. WHEREAS, The Agreement was based on School-Based Mental Health Services. The Amendment includes the following additional services, which are described in more detail in Exhibit A (Additional “Services” or “Work”):
 - Statewide Multi-Payer Fee School-Linked Fee Schedule
 - Wellness Center Services
 - Access to Pacific Clinics Continuum of Care
 ; and
- C. WHEREAS, it is now the desire and intention of the Parties to amend the Agreement as indicated in this Amendment,

NOW, THEREFORE, in light of the foregoing facts and in further consideration of the promises and agreements of the Parties set forth herein below, it is mutually agreed as follows:

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1. The amount reflected in Article 4 of the Agreement, One Million, One Hundred Twenty Three Thousand, Five Hundred Dollars (\$1,123,500.00.) shall be replaced with **One Million, Two Hundred - Fifty Two Thousand, Eight Hundred - Thirty Dollars (\$1,252,830.00)**; with the following monthly fee schedule:

- 2. The Parties acknowledge that this Amendment is subject to approval or ratification by the District Board of Education (“Board”). In the event that the Board rejects this Amendment, none of the Parties shall be deemed to have waived any rights with respect to the Agreement.
- 3. All other provisions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect and are reaffirmed. If there is any conflict between this Amendment and any provision of the Agreement, the provisions of this Amendment shall control.

SCHOOL-BASED MENTAL HEALTH SERVICES

School Based Intervention Team (SBIT)
San Jose Unified School District: Restorative Response Services
Service Options – SY 24/25

Context

Pacific Clinics proposes to provide San Jose Unified School District with Restorative Services for the 24/25 school year. Services can support a range of student, educator, and family/community needs. Services include direct student support (e.g., 1:1), de-escalation, crisis intervention, screening, alternatives to suspension, service plan development, caregiver coaching, teacher consultation, workshops, and case management/linkage. Various mental health related concerns (e.g., maladaptive behaviors, substance use, ASD, ADHD, anxiety, depression, etc.) will be addressed through services. Services will be provided for the duration of the school year, with no services on school breaks. These options can be adjusted based on district needs or preferences. Please see below for information regarding additional services Pacific Clinics can offer for the 24/25 school year.

Statewide Multi-Payer Fee School-Linked Fee Schedule: Pacific Clinics can offer specialized support and consultation with navigation, design and implementation related to participation in the CYBHI fee schedule released by DHCS. This can include, but is not limited to:

- Workflow design for service identification in alignment with CPT billing codes
- Collaboration on Electronic Health Record (EHR) utilization
- Documentation review and consultation on set up.
- Maximization of staff time cross walked with reimbursement pathways.
- Direct billing under the fee schedule by Pacific Clinics for services rendered at the school.

Wellness Center Services: Pacific Clinics can offer consultation, implementation, and operations to support schools with installation and launch of Wellness Centers as requested. This can include:

- Environmental design related to welcoming environment.
- Student development and engagement
- Direct social emotional wellness services
- Coordination of care, referral pathways, and community engagement
- Educator professional development

Direct access to Pacific Clinics Continuum of Care: Pacific Clinics has a robust continuum of care, from prevention to mobile crisis services. Services offered include, but are not limited to:

- Outpatient Services, including medication management.
- First Five referrals and access to Family Resources Centers (FRC) for parents of young children
- Health Plan Services like Care Coordination and Housing Resources – for Medi-Cal Students
- Access for all Students to Pacific Clinics Drop- In Center, with access to recovery supports.
- Coordination for Mobile Crisis Response Services
