### NOTES:

- ◆ **Payment / Group Billing:** All fees are in US Dollars. Accepted forms of payment are organization check, cashier's check, money order, and wire transfer. Credit cards and/or individual payments will not be accepted.
- ◆ **Airfare:** ACTUAL roundtrip airfare has been included in the above costs. Sixty-five (65) seats are currently being held. One (1) gratis air ticket for every twenty (20) paid participants is included. Only the base fare is guaranteed. Taxes and surcharges are subject to change until ticketing. Should additional taxes or surcharges be levied, World Projects retains the right to pass on all such surcharges to Santa Rosa High School.
- ◆ **Air Baggage Fees:** Baggage fees are set by the individual airlines and are subject to change. Currently, Alaska Airlines charges \$35 (one-way) for the first checked bag (up to 50lbs and 62 linear inches), and \$45 (one-way) for a second checked bag (up to 50lbs and 62 linear inches). World Projects has included a fund of \$70 roundtrip per person for first checked baggage fees and a fund of \$2,000 towards second checked, oversized, and overweight baggage fees. Santa Rosa HS will be responsible for baggage fees that exceed these amounts at airport check-in.
- ◆ **Accommodations:** Students will be placed in mostly quad rooms with up to six (6) triples utilized as necessary. Staff / chaperones will be placed in double or single rooms. Quad denotes four (4) people per room / two (2) double beds per room. Triple denotes three (3) people per room / two (2) double beds per room. Sharing beds will be necessary for quad and triple occupancy.
- ◆ **Availability / Ground Costs:** This quote is based on 2025 pricing, subject to availability at the time of booking.
- ◆ **Gratis:** Gratis is based on the double occupancy price.
- ◆ **Travel Protection Plan:** World Projects will purchase a Student Protection Plan (post departure) for all travelers of US-based groups (within the 50 states). Details of the plan will be sent to the group leader.
- ◆ **Required Forms:** All travelers will be required to submit signed liability waivers and medical authorizations forms as issued by World Projects to participate in the festival/tour.
- ◆ **Numbers:** Please note that the New York Wind Band Festival and this package requires a minimum of 45 paid travelers for the group. This minimum may be reached by including all travelers (i.e. performers, staff, and chaperones/adults). This costing is based on a minimum of 45 paid travelers and a maximum of 59 paid travelers.



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World Projects reserves the right to re-cost the festival package should the numbers fall below or above these numbers.

**TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

**1. PAYMENT:** All payments made under this agreement are due on the date stated on the payment schedule below. Payments must be made according to the following schedule to avoid potential default, cancellations, or loss of price guarantee by suppliers. All costs are quoted in US dollars and will be paid to World Projects in US dollars.

**2. ADDENDUM:** Should any changes occur to the Per Person Costs, the Inclusions/Exclusions and/or Payment and Cancellation Schedule as stated in this Agreement, World Projects will issue an addendum which will outline the modified Terms and Conditions as agreed on between World Projects and the group leader.


**3. LATE CANCELLATION CHARGES:** Cancellation of any participant must be made in writing and received at the offices of World Projects Corporation according to the cancellation schedule listed above. Refunds shall be made strictly according to this schedule.

**4. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY; RELEASE:** World Projects Corporation acts solely as an agent in the sale of travel-related services and tours. World Projects Corporation shall therefore not be liable for any breach of contract, failure to comply with any laws, or any intentional or negligent actions or injury to travel participants or travelers' companions or group members. Unless the term "guaranteed" is specifically stated in writing on your tickets, invoice, or reservations itinerary, World Projects Corporation does not guarantee any supplier's rates, bookings, reservations, connections scheduling, or handling of baggage or other personal effects. World Projects shall not be responsible for any injuries, damages, or losses caused to any group or group participant in connection with terrorist activities, social or labor unrest, mechanical or construction failures or difficulties, diseases, local laws, climatic conditions, abnormal conditions or developments, or any other actions omissions or conditions outside World Projects Corporation's direct control. The group and group participants will take part in the travel program at their own risk. The group and group participants assume complete and full responsibility for, and hereby release World Projects Corporation from, any duty of checking and verifying any and all passport, obtaining a visa for the country or countries to be visited vaccination, or other entry requirements of each proposed traveler. By accepting this proposal, the group and group participants voluntarily assume all risks involved in travel, whether expected or unexpected. The group and group participants are hereby warned of the above risks as well as possible travel industry bankruptcies and medical and climatic disruptions, and the possibility the group or group participants may be unable to travel as scheduled because of emergency or other cause. Unless included in the package, groups and group participants represent and covenant that they can obtain appropriate travel insurance coverage against these risks, although there is no requirement that travel insurance be purchased. Group and group participants represent that, unless included in the World Projects' package, they have adequate medical insurance coverage. Group and group participants shall be solely responsible for getting any vaccination or immunization that may be required or advisable for traveling to the location where the performance or tour will take place.

Group and group participants hereby assume full responsibility for all risks of injury or loss, which may result from group and group participants in the performance or tour and agree to indemnify, release, hold harmless, and forever discharge World Projects Corporation, its officers, directors, shareholders, affiliates, employees, agents, managers, independent contractors, and other representatives from and waive any and all claims, liabilities, demands, causes of action, and demands whatsoever that the group and the group participants or any third person has had, may now have or will have in the future with respect to accident, illness, injury, or death of any person, or damage to or loss or destruction of any property arising or resulting from the travel, performance or tour.

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SECTION 1542. GENERAL RELEASE. A GENERAL RELEASE DOES NOT EXTEND TO CLAIMS WHICH THE CREDITOR DOES NOT KNOW OR SUSPECT TO EXIST IN HIS FAVOR AT THE TIME OF EXECUTING THE RELEASE, WHICH IF KNOWN BY HIM MUST HAVE MATERIALLY AFFECTED HIS SETTLEMENT WITH THE DEBTOR.

**5. PARTICIPANT WAIVERS:** It is understood that all group participants in this tour must sign or have their authorized parent or guardian sign a Participant Liability Waiver and Release (Attachment A), and a Medical Authorization, Release, and Waiver Agreement (Attachment B). Failure for any group participant to sign and return the participant waivers no later than the date the last payment is due shall result in the immediate cancellation of any reservations for that group participant. No refunds will be provided if cancellation is the result of the group participant's failure or refusal to sign the participant waivers. **IT IS THE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE GROUP LEADER TO INFORM ALL PARTICIPANTS OF THIS REQUIREMENT PRIOR TO THE ACCEPTANCE OF FUNDS FROM ANY PARTICIPANT.**

**6. NO WARRANTY:** World Projects Corporation expressly disclaims all warranties and conditions, arising by statute or otherwise in law or from a course of dealing or usage of trade. Some states may not allow this disclaimer and its enforceability may vary from state to state.

**7. ATTORNEYS' FEES:** In the event of any dispute arising under or related to this agreement, the parties agree that the prevailing party shall be entitled to its costs and reasonable attorneys' fees.

**8. GOVERNING LAW; ARBITRATION:** The parties to this agreement stipulate that this agreement shall be considered to have been entered into and performed in Benicia, California, that any interpretation of the terms of this agreement shall be made under California law, exclusive of its conflict of laws provisions. Any dispute between the Parties arising out of this Agreement shall be submitted to final and binding arbitration in the City of Walnut Creek, California, USA, under the Commercial Arbitration Rules and Mediation Procedures and the Supplementary Procedures for Consumer-Related Disputes of the American Arbitration Association then in effect, upon written notice and demand of any Party therefor. The arbitration shall be conducted by one (1) arbitrator, in the English language. Any arbitration award rendered shall be binding, final and conclusive upon all parties, and judgment thereon may be entered in any Court having jurisdiction thereof.

**9. RIGHT TO A PROMPT REFUND IN THE EVENT OF CANCELLATION:** Upon cancellation of the transportation or travel services, where the group is not at fault and has not canceled in violation of any terms and conditions previously clearly and conspicuously disclosed and agreed to by the group leader, all sums paid to the seller of travel for services not provided will be promptly paid to the group, unless the group leader advises the seller of travel in writing, after cancellation. This provision does not apply where the seller of travel has remitted the payment to another registered wholesale seller of travel or carrier, without obtaining a refund, and where the wholesaler or provider defaults in providing the agreed-upon transportation or service. In this situation, the seller of travel must provide the group leader with a written statement accompanied by bank records establishing the disbursement of the payment, and if disbursed to a wholesale seller of travel, proof of current registration of that wholesaler.

**10. TRAVEL CONSUMER RESTITUTION FUND (TCRF):** This transaction is covered by the California Travel Consumer Restitution Fund (TCRF) if the seller of travel was registered and participating in the TCRF at the time of sale and the passenger is located in California at the time of payment. Eligible passengers may file a claim with TCRF if the passenger is owed a refund of more than \$50 for transportation or travel services which the seller of travel failed to forward to a proper provider or such money was not refunded to you when required. The maximum amount which may be paid by the TCRF to any one passenger is the total amount paid on behalf of the passenger to the seller of travel, not to exceed \$15,000. A claim must be submitted to the TCRF within 12 months after the



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scheduled completion date of travel. A claim must include sufficient documentation to prove your claim and a \$35 processing fee. Claimants must agree to waive their right to other civil remedies against a registered participating seller of travel for matters arising out of a sale which you file a TCRF claim. 

**13. FULL AND COMPLETE AGREEMENT; SEVERABILITY:** This agreement constitutes the full and exclusive expression of the agreement between the parties, and any modification of the terms set forth in this agreement shall be effective only if in writing and signed by both parties. If any provision of this Agreement is declared void or unenforceable, such provision will be severed from this Agreement, which will otherwise remain in full force and effect.


**14. WARRANTY OF AUTHORITY:** The person signing this agreement on behalf of the group warrants that he or she has full and complete authority to bind the group and each group participant to the terms and conditions in this agreement.



World Projects Corporation is the producer of the 2025 New York Wind Band Festival. In putting this project together, we have made arrangements with hotels, transportation services, airlines, and other independent parties to provide you with travel and lodging services. As consideration for, and an express requirement of your participation in this tour, we require that you understand and agree to a waiver of any claims you might have against World Projects Corporation, as well as agree to be bound by other terms and conditions stated in this waiver. As this is a binding legal document, you should read this document carefully before signing.

By signing this waiver of liability and release, you agree to waive any claim you or your child may have against World Projects Corporation, and to indemnify, release, hold harmless, and forever discharge World Projects Corporation and its officers, directors, shareholders, affiliates, employees, agents, independent contractors, and other representatives (referred to collectively as "World Projects") from any and all claims that you had, may now have, or will have, of loss, liabilities, demands, causes of actions, damage, costs or expenses, including attorneys' fees, arising out of this tour and relating to any injury, accident, death, damage, delay, scheduling conflict, inconvenience, upset, disappointment, distress or frustration, loss or delay of baggage, instruments, or other property, regardless of the cause or of any acts relating to said cause.

Further, by signing this waiver of liability and release in consideration as outlined above, you acknowledge that travel arrangements are inherently unpredictable and subject to change. You further acknowledge and agree that travel can be potentially dangerous and life threatening, and by signing this agreement, you agree to assume this risk and to absolve and hold harmless World Projects from any and all risks of any nature or kind associated with this tour. Group and Group Participants expressly acknowledge and agree that it is and will not be possible for World Projects to foresee, plan for, or mitigate all the consequences that the existence and spread of the SARS-CoV-2 virus may have or cause, including without limitation, delays or cancellations of the trip, possible COVID-19 contagion, quarantine, program changes, and any actions or recommendations by authorities. You also agree to hold World Projects free and harmless from any and all expenses, demands, claims, losses, liabilities, obligations, damages, and costs (including reasonable attorneys' fees) arising out of, in connection with, or brought as a result of, your participation in this tour, or any events incidental to this tour, whether caused by World Projects' negligence or otherwise.

It is also understood and agreed that World Projects has made no promise or pledge, express or implied, to provide any special facilities or services to those with any medical problems, health problems, or physical disabilities of any sort whatsoever. You acknowledge and agree that, unless included in World Projects' package, you are solely responsible for obtaining travel insurance coverage, including medical insurance. You also acknowledge and agree that it is solely your responsibility to get any vaccination that may be required or advisable to travel to the location where the tour will take place.

By signing this waiver, you also consent to have World Projects exercise the right to dismiss or remove any participant in the project for misconduct at any time, and you acknowledge that if you are dismissed or otherwise removed from the project that you will be completely responsible for making arrangements for lodging and transportation, and that no refunds of any funds paid in association with this tour will be made by World Projects.

Authorized Persons may obtain medical treatment from physicians, dentists, staff, technicians and/or nurses on my (or my child’s) behalf and may authorize the use of ambulances, paramedics, hospitals, and other medical facilities, and may authorize performance of any diagnostic procedures, treatment procedures, operative procedures, and x-ray treatment which these medical professionals determine are necessary. I authorize the hospital or medical facility to dispose of any specimen or tissue taken from the participant. I understand that I alone am responsible for the cost of any medical treatment provided for any reason, and that I alone am responsible for any and all consequences arising from or related to such medical treatment.

On behalf of myself, my heirs and my assigns, I hereby release and waive any and all claims related to my medical treatment against Authorized Persons, including but not limited to the selection of any medical, professional, or course of treatment, any authorization given or refused, any consent, failure to provide consent or measures taken or not taken to obtain medical treatment, or failure to obtain prior authorization or any other procedures required by any insurer that I may have. I understand that no person authorized to provide information or authorization is obliged to obtain medical treatment for me (or my child) or to transmit medical information to any person for any reason, and that this authorization and medical history is for my own convenience. This authorization does not create any rights or obligations against any Authorized Persons, and I agree to waive any claims that I may now have, ever had, or will have, and release, indemnify, defend, and hold harmless any Authorized Persons against any such claims, injuries, deaths, damages, causes of action, and liabilities, including requests for expenses and reasonable attorneys’ fees, arising from or related to this Authorization.
