ADVISORY COMMITTEE ON WORKFORCE HOUSING APPLICATION PROCESS

Preparing today's students to be the thinkers, leaders, and creators of tomorrow.

Attracting and retaining high-performing teachers and staff is a priority for San José Unified School District. Stable and affordable housing is essential to the well-being and success of San José Unified's students, families, and employees. As the largest local educational agency in the City of San Jose and the County of Santa Clara, San José Unified is uniquely positioned to positively address our area's affordable housing crisis.

On September 27, 2016, Governor Jerry Brown signed the Teacher Housing Act of 2016 into law which authorizes a school district to establish and implement programs, as provided, that address the housing needs of teachers and school district employees who face challenges in securing affordable housing. On October 19, 2017, the San José Unified School District Board of Education adopted Resolution 2018-10-19-01 on the Affordable Housing Crisis which recognized that stable housing is essential to the well-being and success of San José Unified's students, families, and employees and pledged the District's commitment as a partner in the effort to positively address the City of San José's affordable housing crisis. On August 23, 2018, the Board of Education discussed enrollment and properties and on September 13, 2018, the Board of Education committed to a Master Plan for San José Unified Properties in which four properties were identified that have the best potential to most quickly yield employee housing while optimizing for community benefit. On June 9, 2020, the Board of Education received a Faculty/Staff Housing Assessment from Education Housing Partners assessing the feasibility of these four properties but delayed a discussion due to the response to the COVID-19 emergency. On April 23, 2024, the Board of Education publicly received a presentation from Education Housing Partners on the Faculty/Staff Housing Assessment including updates to the construction costs from the initial report.

To evaluate this assessment and support the next steps in addressing our area's affordable housing crisis, the Board of Education is establishing an advisory committee in accordance with Board Policy 1220. Two members of the Board of Education will be appointed to the committee and select the additional members of the committee. The application process for these members is as follows.
