School is requesting that scan entry be installed at the field house for coaches to enter and security purposes. Maintenance will install.

School is requesting to replace existing door to the school store room with a half door. This the top half to remain open during school store times. Maintenance coordinated requirements with faculty. School funds all cost.

Bear Creek MS

School/Athletic Department is requesting a custom board to highlight records of Track events. BCMS Athletic Department will purchase lightweight 50 lbs. or less, plastic type material. Maintenance will install.

School is requesting that they be allowed to paint inspirational/motivational quotes on walls. Paint is not approved. We are asking schools to use vinyl static cling products instead.

Holsenbeck ES

School is requesting to demo the existing garden at the car riders drive and replace with raised beds, irrigation and compost. Project will be funded by a Farm to School grant. Maintenance will provide a dump trailer for the school to remove and discard existing garden materials. New garden must be maintained by the school.

Plantings should be shrubs not trees in order to create a hedge.

School Agriculture Department is requesting to begin construction on one 8'x8' raised garden bed and four 8'x4' raised garden beds directly outside the RMS Cafeteria. School must maintain beds & keep them weed free.
