

California Youth Behavioral Health Initiative (CYBHI) Fee Schedule Program

Santa Rosa City Schools - Cohort II Participant

Program Overview

Santa Rosa City Schools (SRCS) has been selected to participate in Cohort II of the California Youth Behavioral Health Initiative (CYBHI) Fee Schedule program. This initiative enables Local Education Agencies (LEAs) to receive sustainable funding for behavioral health services provided to students in school settings.

Implementation Timeline

- Selected for Cohort II participation: 2024
- Program Launch Date: January 2025
- Initial Billing Period Begins: January 2025

Service Reimbursement

Under the CYBHI Fee Schedule, Santa Rosa City Schools will be able to:

1. Bill Medi-Cal and commercial insurance for eligible behavioral health services
2. Receive reimbursement for services provided by qualified school-based behavioral health providers
3. Implement billing without any cost-sharing requirements for families (no copayments, coinsurance, or deductibles)

Covered Services

The Fee Schedule program covers behavioral health services including:

- Screening and assessment
- Individual and group interventions
- Care coordination
- Crisis response
- Family engagement
- Consultation with teachers and staff

Program Requirements

To participate in the Fee Schedule program, SRCS will:

1. Maintain appropriate documentation of services
2. Ensure provider qualifications meet program standards
3. Follow all billing and claiming procedures
4. Protect student privacy and medical information
5. Comply with all program reporting requirements

Financial Impact

- Revenue generated through the Fee Schedule will support sustainable behavioral health services and be collected as “Local Revenue”
- No financial burden will be placed on students or families
- Funds can be used to expand and enhance behavioral health services within the district

Student and Family Rights

- Services are voluntary
- No out-of-pocket costs
- Privacy protections for all medical and insurance information
- Right to withdraw consent for information sharing at any time
