Review of SL2021-7

WHO: All Local School Administrative Units

WHAT: School Extension Program

WHEN: After last instructional day of 20-21 school year & prior to first day of 21-22 school year *

WHY: To mitigate the impacts of COVID-19 on at-risk students

** Year-round schools may host program during track-out periods, to be completed by October 1, 2021.*

Process: LEAs

- Qualtrics Survey
 - Required to participate
 - Assurances for legislatively required components
 - OLR required to review and approve
- Two-tiered Approval Process
 - Regional Directors & Office of Learning Recovery
- 115 LEA Submissions
 - 77% approved upon first submission
 - 23% sent back for revisions
 - First Approved: April 25
 - Last Approved: May 27

Process: Charter

- Qualtrics Survey
 - Encouraged to participate
 - No assurances required
 - No formal approval process
- Two-tiered Review Process
 - Office of Charter Schools & Office of Learning Recovery
- 45 Charter Submissions
 - 17 = K-8 Schools
 - 12 = K-12 Schools
 - 9 = K-5 Schools
 - 3 = 9-12 Schools
 - 2 = 6-8 Schools
 - 2 = 6-12 Schools

Notable Findings

100% chose to incorporate the RtA Reading Camp

82% chose 150 hours vs. 30 days for grades K-8

77% chose 150 hours vs. 30 days for grades 9-12

73% chose to use i-Ready for all, or part, of the required competency-based assessments for grades K-8

13% incorporating Summer Bridge or "jump start" programs
