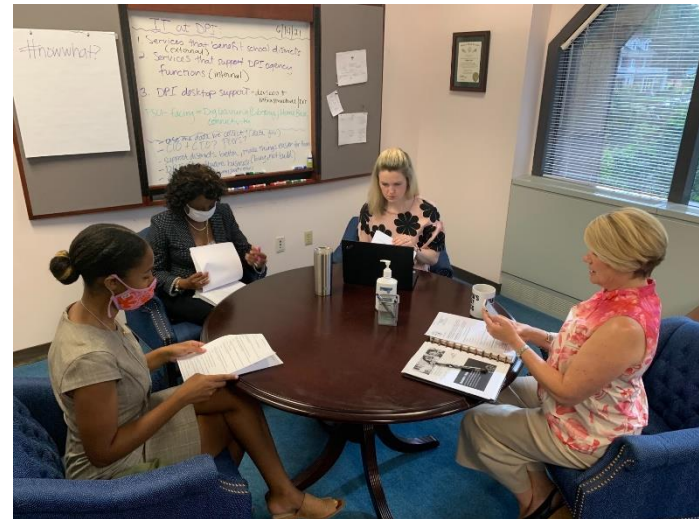

Legislation Process

1. Identify an issue and research it
2. Develop a solution and write a bill
3. Find someone to sponsor the bill (!!)
4. Caucus
5. Run into a problem
6. Run into another problem
7. Vote and get bill passed
