





- There were 93,369.5 teaching positions reported in NC LEAs for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Across the state, there were 3,792.1 (4.1%) instructional vacancies on the 1st day of school.
- Across the state, there were 3,213.9 (3.4%) instructional vacancies on the 40th day of school.
