



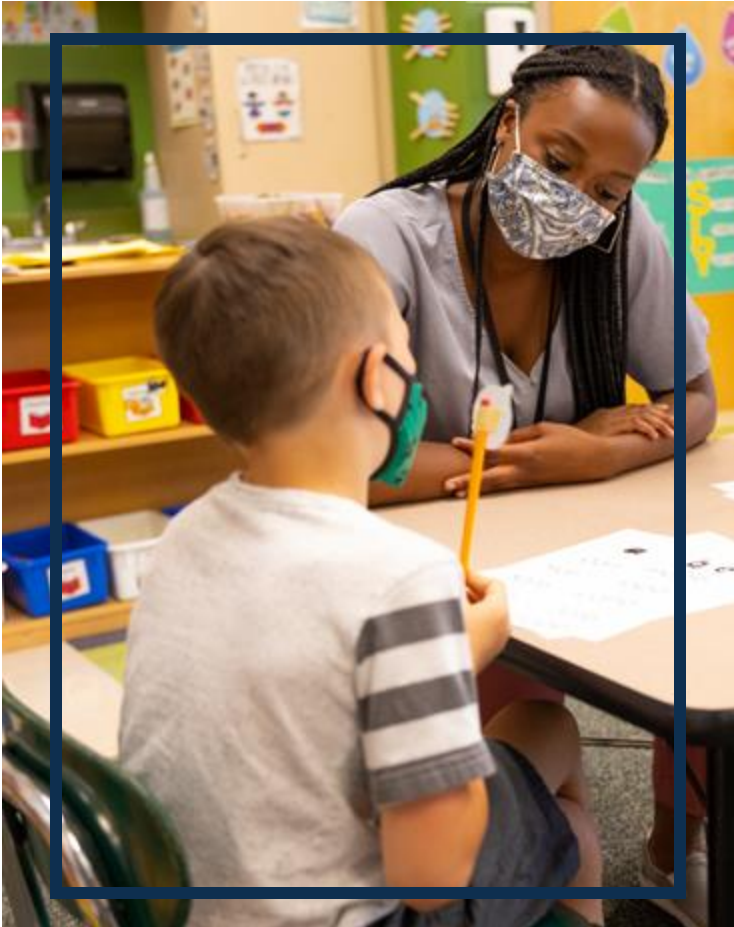

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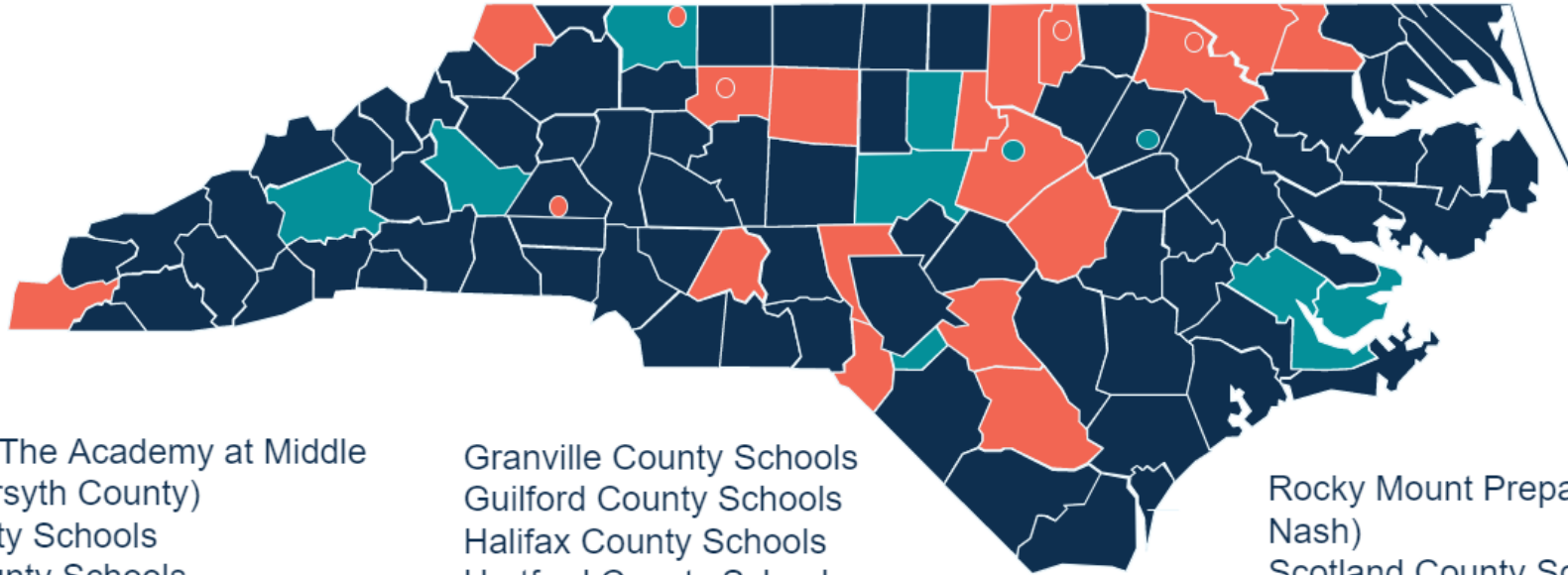

# The fall focus is recruiting, training, & coaching tutors



## Recruitment:

- Our goal: up to 500 literacy tutors this year
  - Current partner demand: 498
  - Candidates Recommended: 554
  - # of tutors hired so far this year: 374
- Tutor profiles
  - Higher ed students
  - Parents and caregivers
  - Retirees, including retired teachers
  - Emerging: high school students, TAs

# All tutors are receiving training and ongoing support



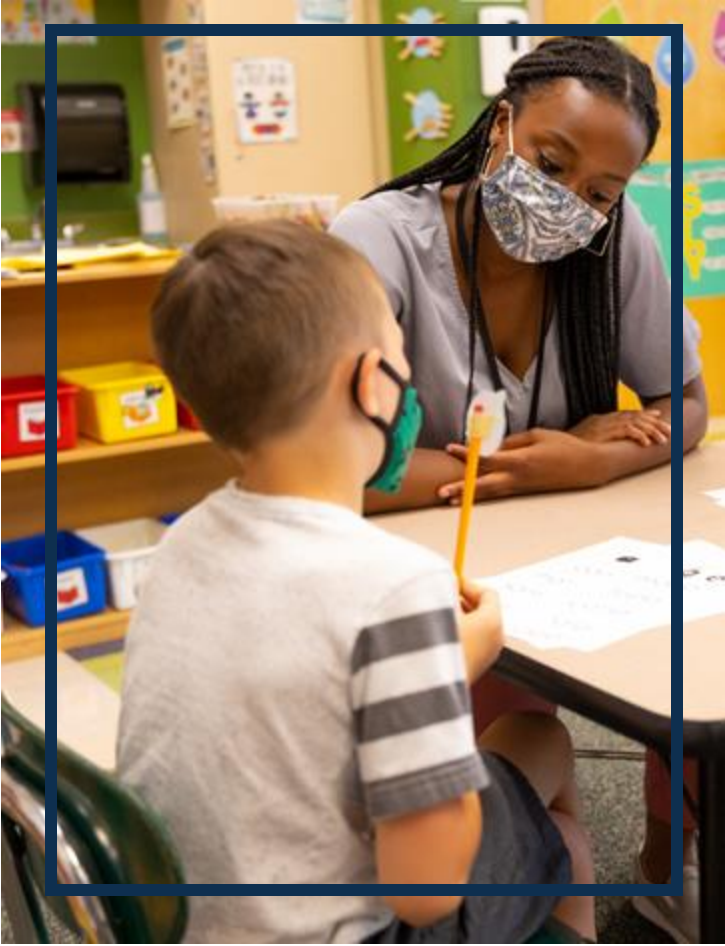
Helping ensure that every tutoring session is a rich and robust learning experience for each student.

- Pre-service - online, asynchronous, aligned with LETRS
- In-service to boost tutoring skills
- Personalized coaching

In 2022-2023, up to 60 hours of training and coaching support.

# Quick Reminder

*High-dosage tutoring: an evidence-based intervention to accelerate student learning*

**Generally when you hear educators or policymakers talk about high-dosage or high-impact tutoring, the definition includes:**

- At least three interactions per week with the student,
- Lasting at least 30 minutes,
- With a maximum student to tutor ratio of 3:1,
- Where the relationships with the tutor is sustained and strong,
- There is monitoring of the student's knowledge and skills, and
- There is coaching or oversight of tutors to ensure high-quality interactions

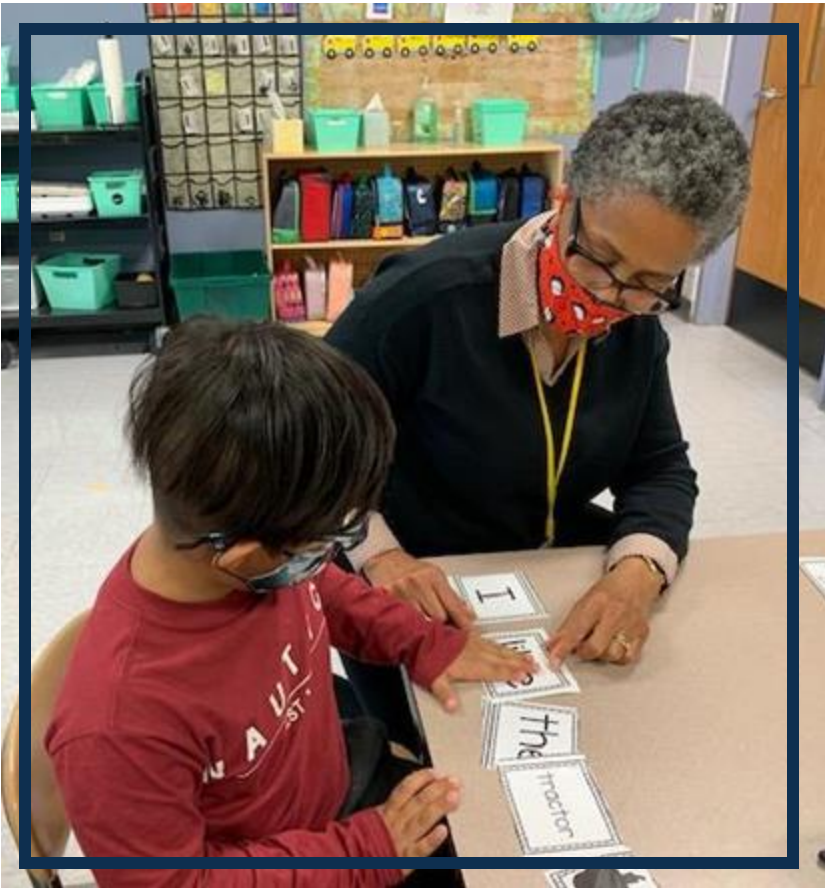
