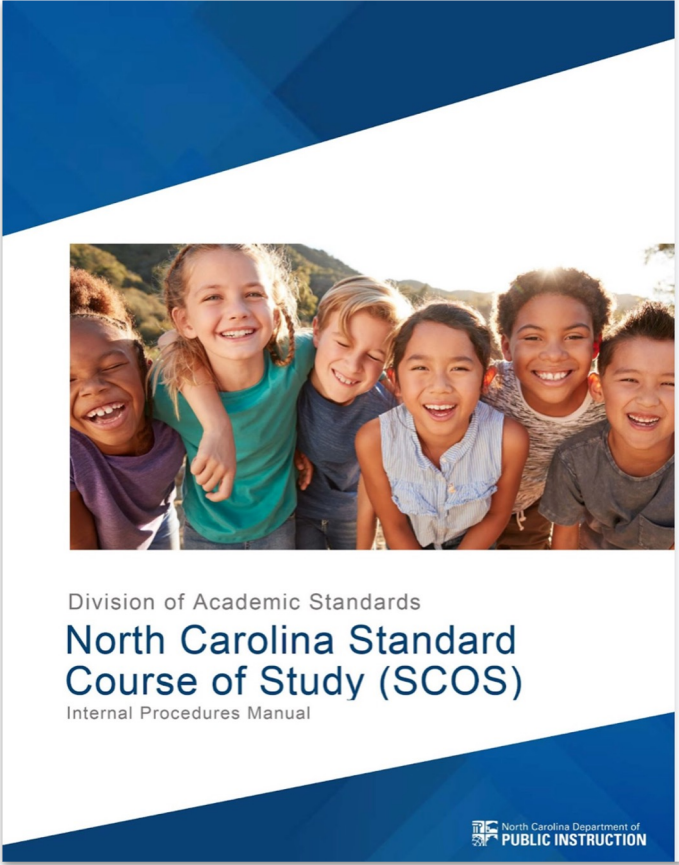
State Board Policy SCOS-012

K-12 Science Updates & Next Steps

Completed Actions:

- ✓ PSU and Stakeholder Standard-by-Standard Surveys closed December 18th
- ✓ Data from the two surveys provided to the Office of Learning Recovery (OLR)

Next Steps:

- Data analysis from OLR will be provided to the Data Review Committee (DRC)
- DRC will complete report for Standards Writing Team (SWT) by end of January
- SWT will then begin second round of edits and revisions
- Second draft of proposed standards will be ready end of February (tentative)
