

16 NCAC 06G .0309 SUSPENSION OF POWERS AND DUTIES OF SCHOOL BOARDS

When the SBE suspends any of the powers or duties of a local board of education pursuant to the provisions of G.S. 115C-105.38(b1) and G.S. 115C-105.39(d), the SBE shall provide written notice to the local board of those powers or duties it is suspending, the reasons for suspending the powers or duties, and the period of time during which those powers or duties shall be suspended. Within the first 45 days following the SBE's notification to the local board, the SBE shall provide the local board an opportunity to present a response to the SBE's decision and propose any action to remedy its prior deficiencies.
