

SCHOOL RULES

Policy Code:

2475

All principals and school personnel are encouraged to initiate improvements to the educational program and services for students through school rules, standards and procedures. Unless specifically addressed by the Board, the Superintendent may determine what matters will be addressed through administrative regulations developed in accordance with policy 2420 – Adoption of Policies, and what matters may be addressed through school rules, standards or procedures established by the principal.

Principals are responsible for school rules, standards and procedures. School rules may not be in conflict with or supersede Board policies or the Code of Conduct.

The Superintendent or designee will annually review Student Handbooks to ensure alignment with Board policy and Code of Conduct. All rules, standards or procedures must be consistent with applicable policies of the Board, the administrative regulations of the Superintendent, and any other applicable laws and regulations.
