PFEA – Grant – Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act (CRRSA – CARES 2)

Recommendation – Action Item

It is recommended that the State Board of Education authorize the State School Superintendent to receive a grant from the United States Department of Education in the amount of \$1,892,092,618 in Federal Funds for the purpose of supporting schools as they are dealing with the effects of the COVID-19 Pandemic, and allocate \$1,702,883,356 to Local Education Agencies (LEA) in the manner required by law.

Scope of Grant:
Georgia will allocate funds in accordance with the CARES 2 legislation that requires funds be distributed in the same proportion as each school district received funds under Part A of Title I of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965, as amended, in fiscal year 2020.

Purpose of Grant:
The purpose of this grant is to provide school districts with emergency relief funds to address the impact that COVID-19 has had, and continues to have, on public elementary and secondary schools across the Georgia and the nation.
