Item Name

FBO – Grant – School Year 2023 (SY 2023) Commercial Warehouse Storage and Delivery Grant

Recommendation – Action Item

It is recommended that the State Board of Education authorize the State School Superintendent to award a grant to School Food Authorities (SFAs) at a cost not to exceed \$ 1,200,000 in Federal Funds for the reimbursement of expenses from SY 2023 for the commercial warehouse storage and delivery of United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Foods.

Rationale

This action will maximize fund usage and reduce the cost of commercial warehouse storage and delivery of USDA foods for the SFAs.

Details

Objective: Reimburse SFAs commercial warehouse storage and delivery expenses for USDA foods.

Grant Amount: \$1,200,000

Performance

Describe how the grant will be monitored to ensure satisfactory performance: Commercial warehouse storage and delivery invoices for USDA foods will be used for grant allocations. These allocations will be disbursed by June 30, 2024. The SFAs will be given allocations based upon warehouse invoices associated with SY 2023 USDA foods warehouse and delivery expenses.

Performance, criteria, and results: The state agency will review and approve all statements and /or invoices submitted for reimbursement up to the authorized amount. SFAs may receive an additional allocation, if remaining grant funds are available.

Performance Metrics: All SFAs with less than four months operating cash resources available are eligible for the grant funds. Invoices for commercial warehouse storage and delivery fees associated with USDA

foods will be required.

Summary

Scope of Grant:

To reimburse SFAs for the expenses incurred for the commercial warehouse storage and delivery expenses of USDA foods during SY 2023.

Purpose of Grant:

To recommend utilization of a portion of School Nutrition State Administrative Expense funds to reimburse SFAs for USDA foods warehouse and delivery expenses.
