### Original Grant Scope and Purpose

#### Scope of Grant:

The Georgia Department of Education has allocated funding for GNETS to provide comprehensive educational and therapeutic services so that students will acquire the skills necessary to be successful in the general education setting and prevent the need for residential or more restrictive placements.

#### Purpose of Grant:

The purpose of this grant is to assist the 24 GNETS with meeting the needs of students with disabilities as determined by their IEPs, assist students with transitioning to less restrictive environments, and improve students' academic and behavioral skills.
