The application was released on September 5, 2023 and closed on October 6, 2023. Any LEA on the Comprehensive School Improvement (CSI), Targeted School Improvement (TSI), and Promise lists, as well as any LEA identified as rural were eligible to apply. Applications were scored on a pre-defined rubric by trained internal staff and external partners.
