Districts and schools were invited to submit grant applications no later than December 4, 2023. Grant applications were scored and managed by trained GaDOE staff. The rankings were based on science program support, intended outcomes, budget, and sustainability of efforts. Geographic distribution and rankings were also used to select the proposed grantees.
