WCS – Grant – FY24 School-Based Health Center (SBHC) Renovation Grant - Hall

Recommendation – Action Item

It is recommended that the State Board of Education authorize the State School Superintendent to award a grant to Hall County Schools at a cost not to exceed \$308,000 in Federal Funds for the renovation and infrastructure of a new school-based health center (SBHC) at Chicopee Woods Elementary School.

Supports the Following Education Goal or Goals in the Agency Strategic Plan

- Foster a safe, healthy, and positive learning climate in every school.
- Expand educational opportunities and non-academics supports in order to maximize student engagement, meet student needs/interests, and ensure the relevance of learning.

Rationale

This grant will provide \$308,000 to Hall County to purchase a modular unit to house their SBHC at Chicopee Woods Elementary School. Hall County received a planning grant in June 2023 and has thus far created an advisory group, conducted a needs assessment, and secured a medical sponsor for their center.

Describe how the grant will be monitored to ensure satisfactory performance: Office of Whole Child Supports staff will continue to perform routine check-ins with Hall County's planning team throughout the course of the grant period to monitor progress. Budgets and spending will be monitored via the Consolidated Application.

Performance, criteria, and results: Satisfactory performance will be determined by whether the SBHC is operational from a construction, safety, and facilities standpoint by the end of the grant period.

Performance Metrics: The primary measure of success for this grant will be a fully operational SBHC.

Funds will be used to support the purchase of a modular unit to house the SBHC at Chicopee Woods Elementary School.

Purpose of Grant:

To provide funds that contribute to the establishment of a SBHC that provides comprehensive, primary healthcare to students at Chicopee Woods Elementary School in Hall County.

The SBHC planning team in Hall County has met the primary objectives to move forward in the development of their SBHC. This is a pre-established amount for renovation funds using the Governor’s Office SBHC grant received by GaDOE in Fall 2022.
