FBO – Grant Amendment– Commercial Warehouse and Storage Grant

Recommendation – Action Item

It is recommended that the State Board of Education authorize the State School Superintendent to amend the grant with School Food Authorities (SFA's) by the amount of \$1,200,000 for a cost not to exceed \$2,400,000 in Federal Funds for the purpose of reimbursement of expenses from Fiscal Year 2023 Commercial Storage and Delivery of United States Department of Agriculture (USDA) Foods.

Performance

Describe how the grant will be monitored to ensure satisfactory performance: State Agency will obtain commercial warehouse storage and delivery statements and/or invoices for School Year (SY) 2022-2023 based on their initial allocations (To Be Determined). The intent is to reimburse up to \$2,400,000 for USDA food warehouse delivery and storage expenses incurred by the SFAs.

Performance, criteria, and results: The State Agency will review and approve all statements and /or invoices submitted for reimbursement up to the authorized amount. SFAs may receive an additional allocation if funds are available.

Performance Metrics: All SFAs with less than four months operating cash resources available are eligible. SFAs must have expenses related to commercial warehouse storage and delivery fees for USDA foods.
