- 1. <u>Supplemental State Aid</u> Supports setting supplemental state aid for FY 2018 by January 27, 2017 and FY 2019 and future years within 400 days (or 14 months) prior to the certification of the school's district budget. In addition, the district desires a rate that adequately supports local districts' efforts to plan, create and sustain world-class schools.
- 2. <u>State Penny</u> Supports preserving the integrity of the statewide penny sales tax for school infrastructure, including tax equity provisions. Supports repeal of the December 31, 2029 sunset while recognizing other statewide priorities.
- 3. <u>Mental Health</u> Supports increased statewide access to and funding for mental health services for children.
