**RE:** **SECONDARY SCHOOLS' SCHOOL PLANS FOR STUDENT ACHIEVEMENT**

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**PURPOSE:** To present for approval the school plans for student achievement for Piedmont Middle School, Millennium High School, and Piedmont High School

**BACKGROUND:**

The PUSD Site Councils serve as a forum where school staff, parents, and students can discuss a variety of issues that affect student performance in Piedmont schools and develop site-based goals to improve student learning. Site Councils discuss topics such as curriculum, communication, and school climate in an effort to educate stakeholders and provide long-range guidance and insight.

The California Education Code requires the school site council to develop a School Plan for Student Achievement (APSA). The purpose of the SPSA is to create a cycle of continuous improvement of student performance and to ensure that all students succeed in reaching academic standards set by the State Board of Education. The School Plan for Student Achievement is developed with the input of all Site Council stakeholders and reflects the current educational needs of students.

The school site council shall be composed of the principal and representatives of: teachers selected by teachers at the school; other school personnel selected by other school personnel at the school; parents of students attending the school selected by such parents; and, in secondary schools, students selected by students attending the school. At both the elementary and secondary levels, classroom teachers shall comprise the majority of persons represented under subdivision (a) of this section.

**NEXT STEPS:**

The PMS, MHS, and PHS Site Councils will continue to meet monthly to discuss the progress on the goals.
